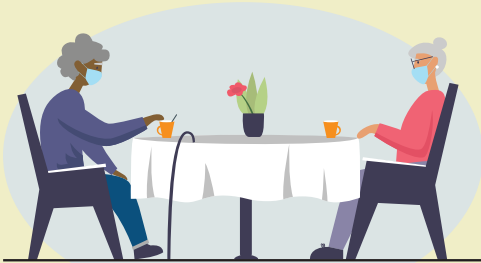


People who Qualify to Receive COVID-19 Vaccine in Florida

Qualified per Executive Order 21-67—Effective Monday, March 22, 2021.



Long-term care residents or staff.



People age 50 & older.



People determined by their physicians to be extremely vulnerable to COVID-19.*



* All individuals authorized by law to administer COVID-19 vaccinations may vaccinate persons determined by a physician to be extremely vulnerable to COVID-19. Such physician determinations shall include a statement that the patient meets the defined eligibility criteria established by the Florida Department of Health's COVID-19 Determination of Extreme Vulnerability form. Point smartphone camera at the code for the form.

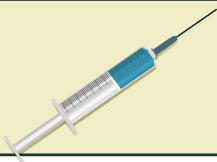
