
If you have tested positive for COVID-19

- Guidelines apply for BOTH vaccinated and unvaccinated people




		
Stay home for 5 days	If you have no symptoms OR your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can leave your house	Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days
(If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves)		

If you have been exposed to COVID-19

- If you have been boosted **OR** received BOTH doses of your Pfizer or Moderna vaccine in the last 6 months, **OR** you received your J&J vaccine in the last two months

		
No need to quarantine	Test on day 5 , if possible	Wear a mask around others for 10 days
(If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home)		

- If you have have NOT been vaccinated **OR** received BOTH your Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago **OR** you received your J&J vaccine over two months ago **OR** are not boosted

		
Stay home for 5 days. After that continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days	Test on day 5 , if possible	If you can't quarantine, you must wear a mask for 10 days
(If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home)

Now that you have been tested, get Boosted or Vaccinated!

- **Seek emergency medical care** immediately, If you experience trouble breathing, persistent pain or pressure in the chest, inability to stay awake, confusion, pale/gray/blue-colored skin/lips/nail beds or symptoms that are severe or concerning to you.
