Palm Beach County's Department of Environmental Resources Management (PBC ERM) in cooperation with the County's Information Systems Services recently released a new tool: the ENVIRONMENTAL ACCESS SEARCH INDEX or EASI. EASI is a web-based Geographical Information System (GIS) application that identifies state registered pollutant storage and petroleum clean-up sites and displays this information in a graphical format. Users can conduct searches and generate maps and reports for the purpose of environmental assessments and monitoring. This tool can be used to identify potential site impacts. Users can locate a property via Property Control Number, municipality, range-township-section, storage tank ID, address or street intersection. A buffer radius can be applied to a specified point or area, and a report and map generated of all requested/available features within the radius. The information can be viewed as point features on aerial photography along with other data such as Palm Beach County's Wellfield Protection Zones and Natural Areas. New facilities and updated information for existing facilities will be added as this information becomes available.
