I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Summary: This action will adopt a Resolution giving the City control over, responsibility for, and ownership of 10th Avenue North from I-95 eastern boundary to North Federal Highway. They plan to rebuild the roadway to provide a more pedestrian friendly environment. The City CRA has asked for a monetary contribution towards this work.

Background and Justification: The City has requested that Palm Beach County transfer 10th Avenue North, from I-95 eastern boundary to North Federal Highway, to the City. This portion of 10th Avenue North is wholly within the City limits. Staff has reviewed the request, has no objections, and recommends adoption of the Resolution to transfer the roadway. This roadway was last resurfaced in 1990 and is due for resurfacing. Staff will bring a funding agreement to the Board in the near future offering the dollars that the County would have put up for this resurfacing to the City CRA for assistance with their roadway revisions.

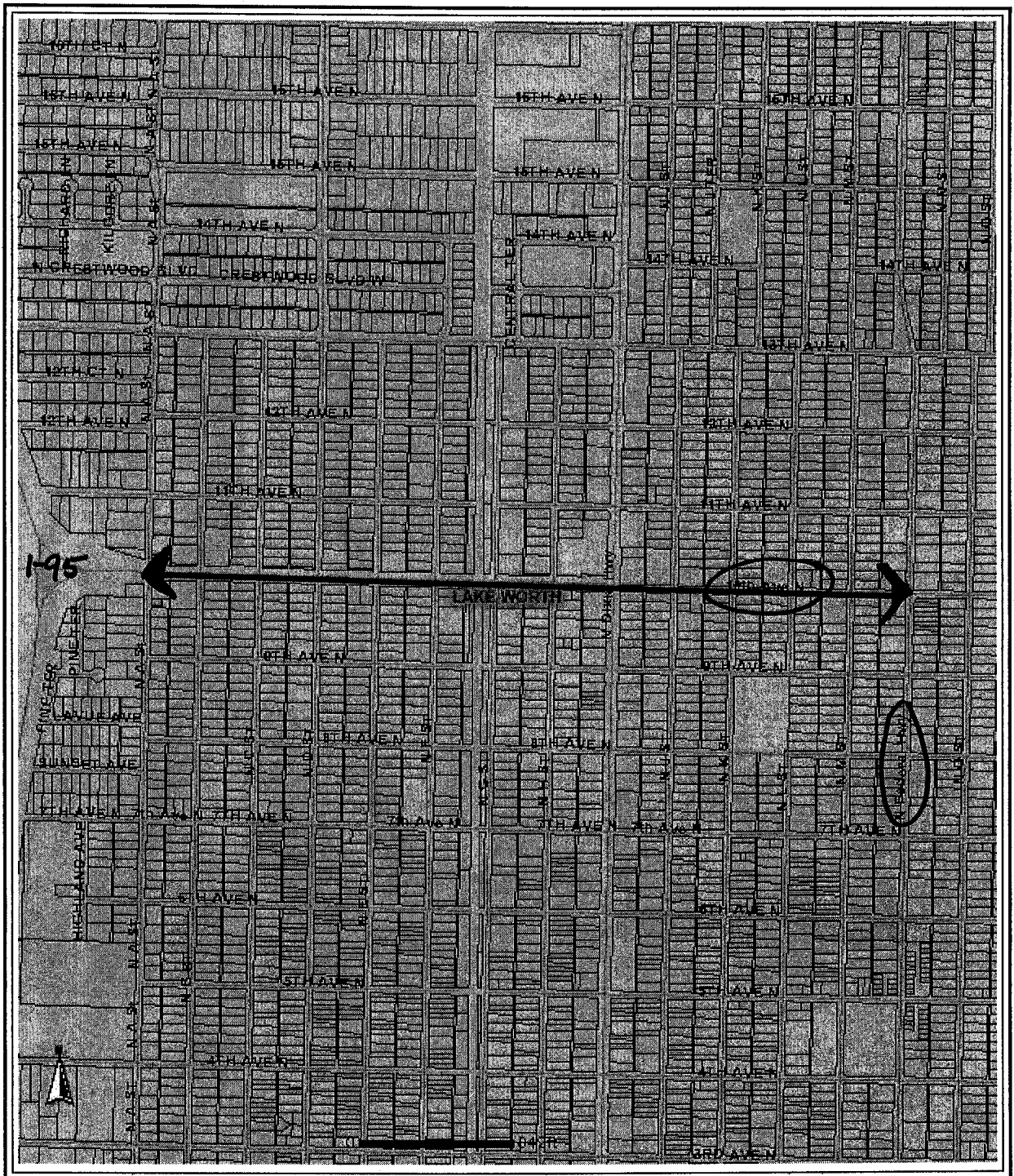

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, TRANSFERRING JURISDICTIONAL CONTROL, MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITIES, AND OWNERSHIP OF 10TH AVENUE NORTH, FROM INTERSTATE 95 (I-95) EASTERN BOUNDARY TO NORTH FEDERAL HIGHWAY, TO THE CITY OF LAKE WORTH.

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County currently has control over, responsibility for, and ownership of 10th Avenue North, from I-95 eastern boundary to North Federal Highway; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Lake Worth city limits encompass this roadway; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Lake Worth has agreed to accept control over, responsibility for, and ownership of 10th Avenue North, from I-95 eastern boundary to North Federal Highway.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

1. This Board adopts and ratifies those matters set forth in the foregoing recitals.
2. That this board does hereby transfer control over, responsibility for, and ownership of 10th Avenue North, from I-95 eastern boundary to North Federal Highway, to the City of Lake Worth.
