I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Contract with The Murphy Construction Co. in the amount of \$983,944.70 for construction of the Jupiter Ridge Erosion Control Project No. 2011ERM04 for a period of 180 calendar days.

Summary: This Project will provide for construction of 23 limestone breakwaters on submerged lands to protect and stabilize shoreline habitat from erosive wave activity caused by boat wakes around the Jupiter Ridge Natural Area in the Intracoastal Waterway. Nine (9) bids were received for this Project. The Murphy Construction Co., a Palm Beach County company, was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder with a bid that exceeds the established 15% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal with 16.75% participation. Funding for this Project includes a \$500,000 award from the Florida Inland Navigation District (R2011-0145) and matching funds from the Manatee Protection Program. District 1 (JM)

Background and Justification: Bids were received through the Department of Environmental Resources Management (ERM) by the Board of County Commissioners on July 19, 2011.


