Background And Justification (Continued):

Section 320.03(6), Florida Statutes, was further amended to provide that an approved local air pollution control program is eligible to receive an additional twenty-five cents (25¢) from the fee, a total of seventy-five cents (75¢), provided the local air pollution control trust fund has an unencumbered balance not exceeding 50% of the previous year's revenue allocation. It is estimated that the unencumbered balance at the end of the current fiscal year will be approximately 30% of the annual revenue thus making the County eligible to continue receiving funding at the 75¢ level. While the proposed FY 2011/2012 budget will exceed previous year revenues by approximately 10%, the trust fund will have sufficient reserves to fund the revenue shortfall.

RESOLUTION NO. 11-

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FY 2011/2012 BUDGET FOR THE AIR POLLUTION CONTROL PROGRAM.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA APPROVING THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND THE PALM BEACH COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE CLERK OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO ESTABLISH THE AIR POLLUTION CONTROL TRUST FUND PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTE 320.03(6)

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County recognizes the need for the control of air pollution; and

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County currently has in effect an Environmental Control Ordianance, Ordinance No. 78-5, as amended, which provides for the adoption by reference of all State Air Pollution rules; and

WHEREAS, the Air Pollution Control Program in the Health Department is an approved and certified program in accordance with S.403.182, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 320.03(6) authorizes the establishment of a local Air Pollution Control Trust Fund with the monies deposited in said fund to be used only for Air Pollution Control programs relating to the control of emissions from mobile sources and toxic and odor emissions, air quality monitoring, and facility inspections pursuant to Florida Statute 320.03(6) or the Palm Beach County Environmental Control Ordinance.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the parties to enter into a contractual agreement to delineate their responsibilities and obligations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COM-MISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

The above statements are hereby affirmed and the Palm Beach County Health Department Air Pollution Control Program is authorized to act as the local Air Pollution Control Program on behalf of Palm Beach County, and the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners is authorized to accept and transfer funds from the Department of Environmental Regulation Air Pollution Control Trust Fund to a County Air Pollution Control Trust Fund for the support of such a program in accordance with Florida Statute 320.03(6).

Be it further resolved that the agreement between Palm Beach County and the Palm Beach County Health Department, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, is approved and the Chairman and Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners are hereby authorized to execute said contract on behalf of Palm Beach County.

AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND THE PALM BEACH COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT FOR THE CONTROL OF AIR POLLUTION

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into at West Palm Beach,

Florida, on this 21st day of August 1984, by and between

PALM BEACH COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida hereinafter referred to as "County", and the PALM BEACH COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT, a Health Unit of the State Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services, hereinafter referred to as "Health Department".

WHEREAS, the County desires to establish an Air Pollution Control Program; and

WHEREAS, the Health Department Air Pollution Control Program is an approved program in accordance with S.403.182, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 320.03(6) authorizes the establishment of a local Air Pollution Control Trust Fund with the monies deposited in said fund to be used only for Air Pollution Control programs, relating to the control of emissions from mobile sources and toxic and odor emissions, air quality monitoring, and facility inspections pursuant to Florida Statute 320.03(6) or the Palm Beach County Environmental Control.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual premises and undertakings contained herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1. The County will adopt the existing Health Department
 Air Pollution Control Program as the approved local Air Pollution
 Control Program specified in Florida Statute 320.03(6)
- 2. The Health Department will administer said local program in accordance with the mandates set forth in Florida Statute 320.03(6); Florida Statute 403; and the Palm Beach County Environmental Control Ordinance.
- 3. The County shall establish a local Air Pollution Control Trust Fund in accordance with Florida Statute 320.03(6).
- 4. The County shall disburse monies from said Trust Fund to the Health Department, and the Health Department will utilize and account for said funds, in accordance with the provisions of

Florida Statute 320.03(6), Florida Administrative Code Chapter 17-2.820, and generally accepted accounting procedures and principles Exhibit 1 is attached hereto as a summary example of the accounting procedure to be utilized.

- 5. The Health Department will submit semi-annual written reports to the County setting forth the goals, objectives and accomplishments of the Local Air Pollution Control Program.
- 6. The Health Department shall submit a proposed budget to the County on an annual basis, the first of which is attached hereto as Exhibt 2 and made a part hereof.
- 7. This agreement shall become effective on the date last signed by the parties below.
- 8. This agreement may be terminated by either party upon 30 days written notice given by either party to the other prior to the proposed date of termination.
- 9. Realth Department shall indemnify and hold harmless County from liability of any kind, including cost expenses for or on account of any suits, actual or threatened, or damages arising out of acts of its employees or program participants during the period of this agreement.
