EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a Budget Transfer of \$20,000 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETF) to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO).

Summary: Florida Statute 932.7055 requires that no less than 15% of the LETF's previous year's revenues be used for the support or operation of drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood and school resource officer programs of various non-profit organizations. The PBSO's FY 2012 estimated donation requirement is \$87,670. The funds are requested to aid qualified organizations that meet the requirements set forth in F.S. 932.7055. The PBSO's support of these programs exemplifies its strong commitment to the prevention and reduction of crime throughout the communities it serves and its desire to put money back into these communities to support organizations that provide such services. The current State LETF balance is \$1,813,300. Approval of this request will reduce the State Law Enforcement Trust Fund balance to \$1,793,300. The year-to-date transfer for all donations after approval of this item is \$769,328. The PBSO certifies that the use of these funds is in accordance with F.S. 932.7055. Below is a table indicating the organizations the PBSO seeks to fund and the corresponding amount of funding proposed per respective agency. No new positions are needed and no additional County funds are required. Countywide (GB)

Background and Justification: The Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office has a long-standing commitment to the reduction of crime and implementation of crime and drug prevention programs within Palm Beach County. Use of LETF requires approval by the Board in accordance with F.S. 932.7055, upon request of the Sheriff. This Statute requires that no less than 15 % of the last fiscal year's revenues be donated or expended for the support or operation of drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood or school resource officer programs. The PBSO certifies that the use of these funds is in accordance with F.S. 932.7055.

Horses Healing Hearts exists to help children in families suffering from substance abuse. Through the magnificence of the human and horse relationship, the kids are taught about responsibility and confidence.

Provide a brief summary of program's activities/services to be funded:

At this time HHH is serving over 25 children in Palm Beach county. These children meet weekly at one of two sponsor barns in Lake Worth and Delray Beach and work with qualified volunteers and psychologists to learn about horse care and how to better care for themselves so that they do not repeat the pattern of addiction that their parents have chosen. We start and end the groups with circle time and each child gets approximately 15 minutes of private ride instruction. We work off of a curriculum that is attached to this application.

What results are you committed to achieving?

We are committed to ensuring that each child is given the opportunity to express themselves and know they have the ability to control their destiny despite the path their parents have chosen. We teach they cannot control many things in their life but they can control their thoughts and actions. We are committed to teaching the participants the skills to choose the right course of action so they may become positive, productive members of society.

These fees are being paid weekly to our sponsor barns for our kids to take lessons. We are being "gifted" or given a free lesson and then we pay for the second lesson. This amount represents that second lesson. Consequently, this is already a discounted amount. This is the "core" of what we do and is a much less expensive way for us to have horses integrated into our program as compared to having our own horses which would be considerably more expensive. We are basically paying "per ride."
