EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- A) a contract with R & D Paving, LLC (R & D) in the amount of \$699,820.90 for the construction of Australian Avenue, West 10th Street to 330' North of West 13th Street intersection improvements (Project); and
- **B)** a budget amendment of \$7,150 in the Road Impact Fee Fund Zone 1 to recognize reimbursement funding from the City of Riviera Beach (\$4,400), and AT&T (\$2,750) and appropriate it to the Project.

SUMMARY: Approval of this contract and budget amendment will allow Palm Beach County to issue a notice to proceed to R & D, a Palm Beach County based company, to begin construction of the Project. The Palm Beach County Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal for all projects is 15% overall. The SBE participation proposed for the Project by R & D is 51.70%.

Background and Justification: Bids for the Project were received by the Engineering Department on July 12, 2016. R & D was the sole responsive, responsible bidder. The Office of Small Business Assistance issued its evaluation on July 21, 2016. Time to complete all work under this contract shall be no more than 120 calendar days.

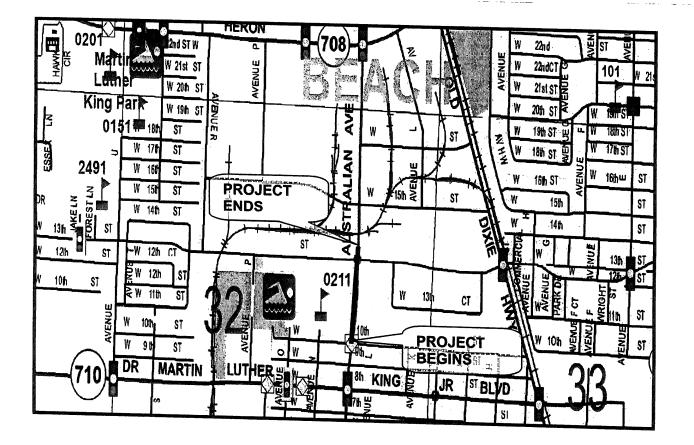

It is understood and agreed that the time limit for completion of said work is the essence of the contract and should the Contractor fail to complete the work within the time limit, it is agreed that for such calendar day that any work provided for in these Contract Documents shall remain incomplete after the time limit has expired, including any official extension of the time limit; the sum per day given in the contained schedules shall be deducted from monies due the Contractor, not as a penalty, but as liquidated damages (in accordance with Section 8-10.2 of the Standard Specifications) and added expense for supervision.
