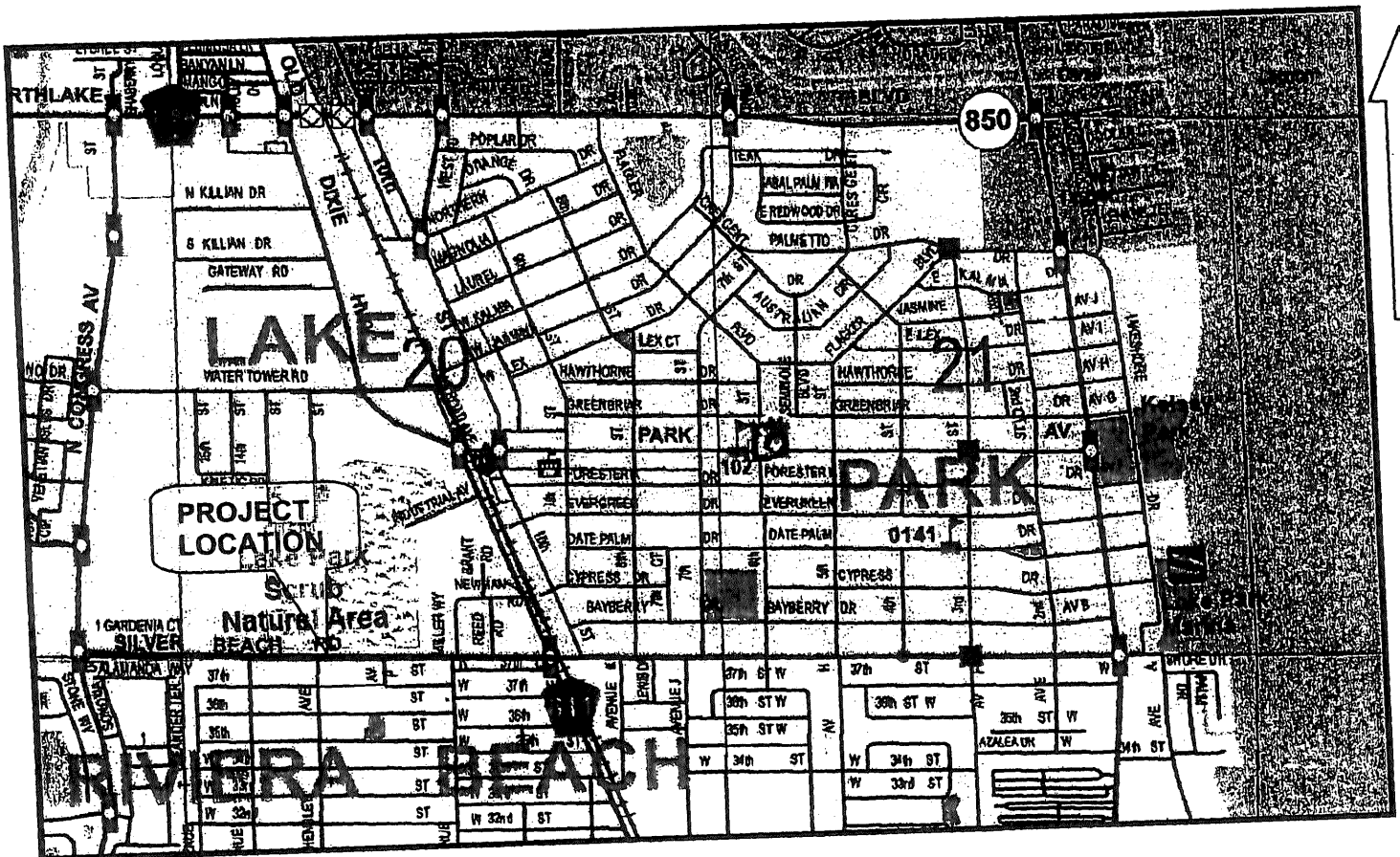

Pursuant with Contract Section 4-3.7, Differing Site Conditions, install 660 LF of water main for The City of Riviera Beach and abandon 800 LF of unforeseen existing City of Riviera Beach water main by grouting. Connect new water main to existing water main, remove and dispose of 2 existing Air Release Valves (ARV), install 1 new ARV. Cost includes mobilization, all fittings, restraints, sample points, maintenance of traffic and allowances for restoration of roadway, swales, sod.

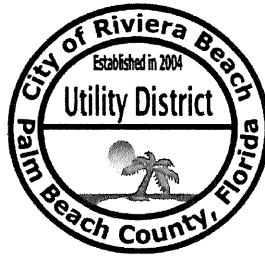

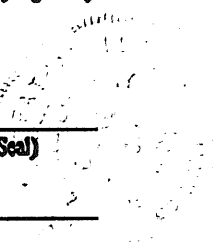

PROVISIONS

A. WHO IS AN INSURED – UNNAMED SUBSIDIARIES

The following is added to **SECTION II – WHO IS AN INSURED**:

Any of your subsidiaries, other than a partnership, joint venture or limited liability company, that is not shown as a Named Insured in the Declarations is a Named Insured if:
