I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 5 to the Consulting/Professional Services Utility Distribution & Collection System Engineering Services Contract (Contract) with Holtz Consulting Engineers, Inc. (Consultant) for the Finfrock Lift Station and Force Main Rehabilitation (Project) for a not to exceed amount of \$139,845.95.

Summary: On December 15, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners approved the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) Contract (R2020-1897) with Consultant. CSA No. 5 provides for professional engineering services relating to design and permitting of the Project. These services include utility locates, surveying, geotechnical engineering, construction plans, permitting and bid support services for the upgrades to the existing lift station and for the replacement of approximately 2,750 linear feet of existing force main from the connection point at the new Finfrock force main aerial crossing to the existing 10-inch ductile iron force main on the west side of SR 715.

This Contract was procured under the requirements of the Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance. On October 2, 2019, the Goal Setting Committee applied an Affirmative Procurement Initiative (API) of a minimum mandatory 20% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) subcontracting goal and an evaluation preference for up to 15 points based upon the relative level of dollar participation by certified SBE firms were the API applied to the Contract. The Contract provides for 96.00% SBE participation, which includes 90.00% MBE participation, 85.00% MBE (H), and 5.00% MBE (A). CSA No. 5 includes 93.24% SBE participation which includes 85.43% MBE participation, 85.43% MBE (H). The cumulative SBE participation including CSA No. 5 is 87.72% SBE, which includes 77.42% MBE participation, 75.71% MBE (H), and 1.71% MBE (A). Consultant is a Palm Beach County based company. The Project is included in the PBCWUD FY22 budget. (PBCWUD Project No. 22-002) <u>District 6</u> (MJ)

Background and Justification: The former Glades Correctional Institution is currently being redeveloped by Finfrock, and as part of the site redevelopment, the developer is upgrading the lift station electrical panel and replacing the existing force main up to the west property line, including an aerial canal crossing. This Project includes the replacement of the remaining section of force main and the rehabilitation of the existing lift station in order to meet the latest PBCWUD minimum engineering standards. Completion of the work provided for in the Project will restore the service life and improve the long term operability and reliability of PBCWUD's wastewater collection system.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

PBCWUD Project No.: 22-002

Project Title: Finfrock Lift Station and Force Main Rehabilitation

INTRODUCTION:

This scope encompasses services for the design, permitting, and bidding to replace the existing force main from the Finfrock site to the west side of State Road 715 (SR 715) and for the civil and mechanical improvements to the Finfrock Lift Station.

BACKGROUND:

The former Glades Correctional Institution is currently being redeveloped by Finfrock and as part of the improvements, the developer is making electrical upgrades to the existing lift station on the site and replacing the existing force main from the lift station, within the Finfrock site, to the west side of the canal on the west side of the property, connecting to the existing force main outside the property limits. The existing force main is over 30 years old and the remainder of the force main from the Finfrock connection point to SR 715 needs to be replaced as well. The existing lift station is also beyond its useful life and requires civil and mechanical improvements in addition to the electrical improvements being performed by the developer.

The Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) has requested Holtz Consulting Engineers, Inc. (CONSULTANT) to assist with the replacement of the remaining section of force main and with making civil and mechanical improvements to the lift station to bring it to current PBCWUD standards where feasible.

CONSULTANT shall perform surveying, geotechnical engineering, engineering design, permitting, and bidding assistance services for the replacement of approximately 2,750 linear feet of existing force main from the connection point at the new Finfrock force main aerial crossing to the existing 10-inch ductile iron force main on the west side of SR 715 (see Figure 1 for location and limits of proposed force main). The new force main size will be determined by PBCWUD and will be a maximum of 8 inches in diameter. CONSULTANT will also perform engineering design, permitting, and bidding assistance services for the civil and mechanical improvements to the lift station. Additional engineering during construction may be requested in a future Consultant Services Authorization (CSA).

SCOPE OF SERVICES

CONSULTANT shall perform and be responsible for the engineering Scope of Services as described herein.

Task 1 - Project Record Review

Subtask 1.1 – Kick-off Meeting and Site Visits:

- Attend one (1) kick-off meeting with PBCWUD staff to discuss project goals, request records, review the scope of services and schedule, and prepare meeting minutes with a list of action items with responsible parties and due dates.
- Visit the project site with PBCWUD staff to review and confirm scope of work.

Subtask 1.2 – Review Records and Geographic Information Systems (GIS)

CONSULTANT shall review available as-built record drawing information for the existing PBCWUD force mains and the developer plans for the Finfrock site. These drawings will be used to assist in preparing the force main connection locations and routing. At PBCWUD's request, the CONSULTANT will assist PBCWUD with obtaining copies of the available as-built drawings by reviewing GIS records and requesting specific record drawings from PBCWUD.

Subtask 1.3 - Wet Well Drawdown Tests

During the site visit, the CONSULTANT shall assist PBCWUD staff to perform and record wet well drawdown tests. Drawdown tests will be conducted a minimum of two (2) times per pump where possible.

Subtask 1.4 - Pump Data Collection and Review

CONSULTANT shall coordinate with PBCWUD's staff to obtain pressure data, flow data, pump run times and other information required for evaluation of the required pumping capacity of the lift station to determine if larger or smaller pumps will be required. PBCWUD will provide CONSULTANT with lift station average daily influent flows.

Subtask 1.5 - System Curves and Pump Selection

CONSULTANT will use the pressure data to create a low-pressure system curve and a high-pressure system curve. The low and high-pressure system curves shall be plotted together with the selected pump curves from each of PBCWUD's pre-approved pump manufacturers.

Task 1 Deliverables:

- Meeting minutes with list of action items in portable document format (PDF).
- Drawdown test results, system curves and pump selection report.

Task 1 Assumptions:

- PBCWUD staff will determine the size of the force main to be designed.
- PBCWUD has an easement for the existing force main and the new main will be installed in the same easement.
- PBCWUD shall provide available record drawings for the existing force mains.
- PBCWUD staff will assist with performing all wet well drawdown and pressure tests.
- PBCWUD shall provide the most recent record drawings for the lift station in AutoCAD and PDF format.
- PBCWUD shall provide lift station average daily influent flows.
- PBCWUD shall identify the minimum and maximum anticipated connection pressures for the lift station and the pressure location/elevation within the system.

Task 2 – Utility Locates

Subtask 2.1 Sunshine One Call and Underground Utility Locates

Under this task, the CONSULTANT shall call in a Sunshine One Call Design Ticket and contact utility companies listed on the design ticket that may have underground or aboveground service lines, utilities, easements, or structures within or adjacent to the project limits. CONSULTANT will request location, alignment, size, diameter, material, and depth of cover of existing facilities in order to avoid conflicts with proposed improvements. If record drawings are not available, CONSULTANT will request that the utility mark and provide the best available information on a plan view sheet. If the company has no existing utilities in the area, CONSULTANT will request that the utility confirm such by stating that there are no utilities in the area. If existing utility information is not available, CONSULTANT will perform horizontal locations of existing detectable utility mains using electromagnetic (EM) and ground-penetrating radar (GPR) techniques, mark selected targets on the ground surface as necessary, and review onsite discoveries with onsite personnel/surveyors, where applicable.

Subtask 2.2 Soft Digs

CONSULTANT will provide services to conduct one (1) soft dig to confirm the depth, diameter, and material of the 10-inch ductile iron force main on the west side of SR 715 where the new force main will connect via wet-tap.

Task 2 Deliverables:

• Report provided by CONSULTANT in PDF indicating findings of utility locates performed.

Task 2 Assumptions:

 The existing force main on the west side of SR 715 is in the grass shoulder and no maintenance of traffic, asphalt road restoration, or permitting will be required to perform the soft dig.

Task 3 – Survey

Under this task, CONSULTANT shall perform a topographic survey of the existing force main/proposed force main route, depicting the horizontal and vertical location of visible facilities and surface features. The following will be included as part of the survey efforts for this project:

- 1. Obtain horizontal and vertical control for this project using information published by the Palm Beach County Engineering and Public Works Department Roadway Production Division, Land Survey Section utilizing State Plane Coordinates for horizontal control and the North American Vertical Datum of 1988 (NAVD 88) for vertical control.
- 2. Location of visible, fixed improvements within the existing force main easement/proposed force main route depicting the horizontal and vertical location of facilities.
- 3. Provide one cross-section of the existing irrigation canal for the design/permitting of a new force main crossing.
- 4. Location of above-ground existing utilities: Florida Power & Light Company (FPL), AT&T, cable TV, natural gas, potable water (valves, fire hydrants, and meters), force mains (valves), sanitary sewer, reclaimed water mains (valves), storm sewers, including information on invert elevations, pipe size, type, and direction for storm and sanitary infrastructure.
- 5. Provide and reference two (2) site benchmarks. Elevations to be referenced to an existing established City of Belle Glade or County Benchmark.
- 6. Locate utilities marked in the field with paint or flags and incorporate them into the survey file.

Task 3 Deliverables:

An electronically signed and sealed PDF file of topographic survey drawings.

Task 3 Assumptions:

- The new force main will be located in the existing force main easement. It is not anticipated that any temporary construction easements will be necessary.
- PBCWUD shall provide record drawings of the lift station completed by the developer (Finfrock) as part of the developer's electrical and civil improvements to the lift station.
- Survey of the existing lift station is not included, and the lift station improvements will be depicted on the lift station record drawings provided by PBCWUD from the developer in AutoCAD format.

Task 4 - Geotechnical Investigation

The CONSULTANT shall perform a subsurface exploration and geotechnical study to obtain subsurface soil information necessary for the proper design of a new canal crossing. The work includes one (1) Standard Penetration Test (SPT) to a depth of 35 feet in the vicinity of the irrigation canal. The boring will be performed in general accordance with procedures recommended in the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) D-1586, using a truck-mounted drilling rig. A geotechnical report with a site plan showing the location of the boring, logs of the exploratory boring, results from SPT samples, identification of organics, and anticipated groundwater levels and will be made available to potential bidders for informational purposes only.

Task 4 Deliverables:

• One (1) PDF file and three (3) hard copies of signed and sealed geotechnical report.

Task 4 Assumptions:

• It is assumed that all borings will be conducted within PBCWUD easements and that no permits will be needed to complete the geotechnical investigation.

Task 5 - Design

The CONSULTANT shall provide engineering services consisting of the preparation of drawings and specifications depicting the proposed force main replacement and lift station improvement work suitable for public bidding and construction of the work.

This bid package is anticipated to have approximately 21 required engineering drawings. The drawings will generally include:

- Cover Sheet
- Sheet Index
- Location Map Sheet
- Legend Sheet
- General Notes Sheet
- Six (6) Force Main Plan Sheets
- One (1) Canal Crossing Profile Sheet
- One (1) Lift Station Existing Site/Demolition Plan
- One (1) Proposed Lift Station Site Plan & Profile
- Up to six (6) PBCWUD's standard detail sheets supplemented by one (1) additional Civil Detail Sheet, as necessary

The drawings will include PBCWUD's standard details. These will be supplemented with the CONSULTANT's standard details. The PBCWUD's Minimum Design & Construction Standards will be supplemented with the CONSULTANT's standard specifications as applicable to the project for preparation of the project technical specifications to be included in the bidding documents.

Subtask 5.1 60% Submittal

The CONSULTANT shall provide one (1) digital PDF set for review and at PBCWUD's request, up to two (2) full-size (22" x 34") sets and five (5) half-size (11" x 17") sets of plans (all legible including detail sheets) for review and comment by PBCWUD at the 60% complete stage. The submittal will also include a draft outline of the specifications table of contents and an Engineer's Opinion of Probable Construction Costs (EOPCC).

Subtask 5.2 90% Submittal

The CONSULTANT shall provide one (1) digital PDF set for review and at PBCWUD's request, up to two (2) full-size (22" x 34") sets and five (5) half-size (11" x 17") set of plans (all legible including detail sheets) for review and comment by PBCWUD at the 90% complete stage. The submittal will address PBCWUD's comments on the 60% submittal and will also include an updated table of contents and a complete draft of the technical specification sections and an EOPCC will be provided.

Subtask 5.3 Bid Submittal

The CONSULTANT shall prepare bid documents incorporating permitting comments available at the time of bidding submittal development. CONSULTANT will provide Computer-Aided Design (AutoCAD) files of the drawings. The CONSULTANT will also provide an electronically signed and sealed PDF file of the CONSULTANT's bid submittal drawings and specifications and an EOPCC will be provided. CONSULTANT shall also provide Microsoft Word (Word) files and one set of un-bound technical specifications and a bid schedule for preparation of bid sets. The CONSULTANT will provide PBCWUD with up to three (3) full-size (22" x 34") signed and sealed sets of the CONSULTANT's final plans and three (3) signed-and-sealed copies of the technical specifications upon final completion for PBCWUD's use in the bidding of the project.

Task 5 Deliverables:

- One (1) electronic PDF file of the submittal package and up to two (2) full-size sets and five (5) half-size sets of the 60% complete submittal package.
- One (1) electronic PDF file of the submittal package and up to two (2) full-size sets and five (5) half-size sets of the 90% complete submittal package.
- One (1) electronic PDF file of the signed-and-sealed submittal package on a flash drive and up to two (2) full-size sets of the drawings (drawings in AutoCAD; specifications in Word).
- One (1) electronic PDF file of the EOPCC will be provided with the 60%, 90%, and bid submittals.

Task 5 Assumptions:

- Updating of record drawings is not included in this task.
- The proposed force main will be depicted in plan view and a profile view will be prepared for the canal crossing and SR 715 crossing only.
- CONSULTANT will use its best knowledge and efforts in good faith to prepare an EOPCC, but CONSULTANT has no control over or responsibility for the cost of materials or labor of the Construction Contractor, market conditions, or the Construction Contractor's means, methods, sequences, scheduling, and techniques of construction, and thus cannot be responsible for any cost deviations and differences, however significant, of the Construction Contractors' bids in comparison to the CONSULTANT's EOPCC.

Task 6 - Permitting

CONSULTANT shall prepare and submit permit applications as required by the governing regulatory agencies. CONSULTANT will coordinate with the permitting agencies during the review process on a regular basis in an effort to keep the project on schedule and shall respond to review comments and Requests for Information (RFIs). Permits will be required from the following agencies:

- Palm Beach County Health Department
- Florida Department of Transportation
- South Florida Conservancy District

Task 6 Deliverables:

- Electronic PDF files of the draft and final permit applications.
- Signed and sealed sets of plans required for permit application submittal packages.
- Permit tracking spreadsheet indicating permit application submission, RFIs, and permit approval dates.

Task 6 Assumptions

- PBCWUD will be responsible for all applicable permit fees.
- All permitting submittals will be electronic.

Task 7 – Bidding Phase Services

Attend a pre-bid meeting, attend one (1) site visit, and prepare meeting minutes for PBCWUD to issue to plan holders. Respond to questions bidders may have concerning the CONSULTANT's bid documents and issue addenda as necessary to clarify the CONSULTANT's bid documents. Evaluate bids and prepare a recommendation of award. Within two (2) weeks of PBCWUD requesting Conformed Contract Documents, CONSULTANT will produce Conformed Contract Documents associated with the CONSULTANT's work incorporating Bid Addenda and provide PBCWUD with:

- Four (4) full-size (22" x 34") drawing sets (signed and sealed, stamped, and issued for construction)
- Six (6) half-size (11" x 17") drawings sets (signed and sealed, stamped, issued for construction)
- A summary of permit statuses
- · Copies of all accepted permits
- One set of conformed technical specifications

CONSULTANT will provide two (2) flash drives containing the above documents in PDF and the drawings in AutoCAD (version 2020 or later) for PBCWUD and the Contractor's use preparing Record Drawings.

Task 7 Deliverables

- Bid documents
- Meeting minutes and sign-in sheets from the pre-bid meeting and site visits
- Addenda, if required
- Recommendation of award
- Conformed documents

Task 8 - Project Management

Project management includes contract administration, quality assurance/quality control (QA/QC), and project meetings with PBCWUD staff.

Subtask 8.1 Contract Administration

The progress of the project will be monitored, and resources will be managed to achieve the schedule, budget, and work quality goals of the project. The CONSULTANT will coordinate with PBCWUD staff and will keep PBCWUD informed as to the status and progress of the project.

Communications with PBCWUD will be conducted under this task. Invoices shall be prepared monthly.

Subtask 8.2 Quality Assurance/Quality Control (QA/QC)

The CONSULTANT will be conducting internal QA/QC review of the deliverables for conformance to contract and internal program requirements. The results of these reviews will be incorporated into the deliverables prior to submission to PBCWUD for review and comment.

Subtask 8.3 Monthly Schedule Update

Submit electronically a project schedule on a monthly basis. This schedule will be submitted on the first Friday of every month for the duration of the contract.

Subtask 8.4 Project Design Review and Coordination Meetings

Attend and participate in project meetings with PBCWUD staff. Up to four (4) meetings have been budgeted for as follows:

- 1. Attend up to four (4) meetings total during the design phase of the project. Meetings are anticipated as follows:
 - a. One (1) 60% complete submittal review meeting
 - b. One (1) 90% complete submittal review meeting
 - c. One (1) final review meeting before the project is bid or awarded to the Contractor
 - d. One (1) design coordination meetings

Task 8 Deliverables







As requested, **TIERRA SOUTH FLORIDA**, **INC.** (**TSF**) is pleased to submit this proposal for the above-referenced project. This proposal includes an outline of our proposed scope of work, an estimate of the total fees, and our anticipated schedule for completion of the work.

PROPOSED SCOPE OF WORK

All work performed by TSF will be in general accordance with PBC standards. We understand that replacement of an aerial crossing over a canal will be required in a force main replacement project in Belle Glade. As requested, TSF will perform one (1) Standard Penetration Test (SPT) boring to a depth of 40 feet for the proposed aerial crossing replacement.

Boring location will be approximately located and noted in the field by our personnel by measuring distances with a tape from known reference points. Elevation at boring location can be interpreted from topographic plans if furnished by others. Prior to drilling at the project site, TSF will notify the local utility companies and request that underground utilities be marked. Our experience, however, is that the utility companies will not mark privately owned utilities. Our proposal assumes that private utility lines will be located in the field by others prior to mobilization of the drill rig. TSF will recommend a utility line locating service upon request.

Upon completion of the field exploration, laboratory testing will be performed on selected samples. A geotechnical engineer will evaluate the results of all drilling and laboratory testing. A report will be issued that contains the exploration data, a discussion of the site and subsurface conditions, evaluation, estimated pile capacities and a discussion of some construction considerations.

ESTIMATED FEES

It is proposed that the fee for the performance of the services outlined above is determined on a unit price basis in accordance with the attached Fee Schedule. On the basis of the proposed quantities, it is estimated that the total fee will be approximately as noted below:






