The County has expended or encumbered \$149,661 (\$19,955/month) during the previous seven and one half (7.5) months of the current twelve (12) month term contract. The Water Utilities Department requests an increase of \$17,001 over the previous authorized amount of \$199,999, for the remaining four and one half (4.5) months of the current term contract. This increase is necessary due to the need for replacement of a UPS unit at the Northern Region Operations Center, which is unrepairable and a safety hazard. The contract amount for the: (i) initial twelve (12) month term was \$103,500, which was increased to \$113,500, with \$83,490 expended; and (ii) first twelve (12) month renewal term was \$167,000. This term contract has three (3) twelve (12) month renewal options. Awardee is located outside Palm Beach County in the City of Deerfield Beach, Florida. Awardee is a sole source provider who is not a certified S/M/WBE. This sole source contract is exempt from the EBO Ordinance.

The County has expended or encumbered \$210,240 (\$18,688/month) during the previous eleven and one quarter (11.25) months of the current twelve (12) month term contract. Due to the continued need for landscape installation services, \$1,509,000 is needed to meet the County's requirements through the expiration of this new twelve (12) month renewal term contract. This term contract has three (3) twelve (12) month renewal options remaining. Awardee is located in Palm Beach County. This contract is awarded to a certified S/M/WBE who is also utilizing an S/M/WBE subcontractor (James F. Schnelle). The original contract was established by a competitive solicitation process. This item was reviewed and approved for renewal by the OEBO.

The County has expended or encumbered \$221,863 (\$22,187/month) during the previous ten (10) months of the current twelve (12) month term contract. Due to an increase in new client enrollments, \$400,000 is needed to meet the County's requirements through the expiration of this new twelve (12) month renewal term contract. The contract amount for the: (i) initial twelve (12) month term was \$200,000, which was increased to \$290,000, with \$266,975 expended; (ii) first twelve (12) month renewal term was \$300,000 with \$247,834 expended; (iii) second twelve (12) month renewal term was \$300,000 with \$268,888 expended; and (iv) third twelve (12) month renewal term was \$300,000. This term contract has no renewal options remaining. Awardees are located in Palm Beach County. The original contract was established by a competitive solicitation process. This Federally funded contract is exempt from the EBO Ordinance.

The County has expended or encumbered \$1,448,647 (\$23,365/month) during the previous sixty-two (62) months of the current sixty-three (63) month term contract. \$1,868,600 is needed to meet the County's requirements through the expiration of this new sixty (60) month pre-qualification term contract. Approval is also requested to add vendors that may become pre-qualified during the term of the contract. Pre-qualification contracts allow for the addition of new vendors during the full term of the contract. This term contract has no renewal options. One (1) Awardee is located in Palm Beach County in the City of Orlando, Florida. No S/M/WBE vendor submitted a bid on this project. The Goal Setting Committee recommended an SBE Price Preference for this solicitation.

The County has expended or encumbered \$442,740 (\$30,534/month) during the previous fourteen and one half (14.5) months of the current fifteen (15) month term contract. Due to fluctuating fuel prices, \$450,000 is needed to meet the County's requirements through the expiration of this new twelve (12) month term contract. This term contract has four (4) twelve (12) month renewal options. Awardee is located out of State. There is no S/M/WBE currently certified for this commodity or service. This item was reviewed by the OEBO and a Waiver of API Requirements was approved.
