I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Supplement No. 4 (Supplement) to the Congress Avenue from north of Northlake Boulevard to Alternate A1A (Project) Contract (R2013-1537), dated November 5, 2013 as amended on August 20, 2019 (R2019-1126) (CONTRACT) with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. (KHA), in the amount of \$178,877.85 for professional services for the Project.

SUMMARY: Since the Project began, coordination with developers, utility owners, the FEC Railway and adjacent property owners has resulted in the redesign of the proposed geometric lane configuration and drainage system for the corridor. Approval of this Supplement will provide the professional services necessary to revise the drainage design and associated permits for the Project. The Contract was approved on November 5, 2013, prior to the effective date of the Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance and pursuant to the Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Ordinance at the time. The SBE goal for all contracts was 15%. KHA agreed to 20.70% SBE participation for the Contract. However, because of concerns with SBE environmental subconsultants and the urgency to complete the Project, the Office of Equal Business Opportunity approved reducing the SBE participation to 14.46% on February 25, 2021. KHA did not agree to any SBE participation for this Supplement. Their cumulative SBE participation to date for the Contract including this Supplement is 13.96%. KHA plans to meet their SBE commitment by the end of the Project. Prior to this meeting date, \$1,143,667 has been encumbered under this Contract. KHA has an office located in Palm Beach County. This Project is included in the Five-Year Road Program. District 1 (YBH)

Background and Justification: On November 5, 2013, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the Contract with KHA to provide professional services required for the Project. The fee, as detailed in **Exhibit B** of the attached Supplement, has been negotiated as just and reasonable compensation as follows:



I. DESCRIPTION AND BACKGROUND

The proposed Congress Avenue extension project from Northlake Boulevard to Alternate A1A will be modified to revise the drainage design. Segment A south of Avocado Blvd. was permitted and put out for bidding. The drainage for Segment A was accommodated within a proposed development in the Hilltop property and permitted accordingly. Since the project was bid, the owner/developer voided the previous development design. This required that Segment A drainage be redesigned to discharge into relocatable dry detention areas within the Hilltop vacant property to provide the developer with flexibility in future development of the property. The currently designed and permitted drainage structures and outfalls from Segment A into the linear dry detention areas running along the west right of way line of Congress Avenue will remain at their location to the extent possible. The linear dry detention area will be modified and extended to the south property line of Hilltop then extended west to the C-17 Canal to connect to a proposed pipe outfall. Segment B north of Avocado Blvd was also permitted based on acquisition of a pond within the Hi Acres mobile Home Park. After 96% phase completion of Segment B, the County wishes to redesign to reduce the detention pond size within the Hi Acres property. It is assumed that Segment B will provide stormwater attenuation and connect an outfall pipe from the Avocado Dr. intersection into the linear dry detention area of Segment A that will ultimately outfall into the C-17 Canal at the south end of the Hilltop property.

The scope consists of revising drainage calculations, drainage report, roadway plans, drainage plans and the approved SFWMD permits for both Segments A and B. The current roadway plan and profile design will remain as is except for the addition of a new southbound right turn lane to the driveway at Station 112+40.

II. SCOPE OF SERVICES

<u>TASK 1</u> Roadway Analysis – The scope of the roadway analysis work for both Segment A and B consists of the following:

- Coordination meetings with County staff to review potential solutions
- Assess drainage revision impacts on roadway design
- Incorporate new relocatable linear dry detention area into roadway design for Segment A.
- Incorporate a revised reduced dry detention pond into roadway design for Segment B
- The developer has requested that the County incorporate an additional southbound right aim lane into the Hilltop Development; this will be included in the updated design
 - The County has requested that a physical bulb out be placed just past the second entrance to the development to limit through traffic from using the new southbound right turn lane as a through lane.

- Update signing and pavement markings to incorporate new turn lane and physical bulbout.
- Revise and update cross sections
- Maintain current profile grade line design
- Recalculate pay item quantities
- Update opinion of probable costs

<u>TASK 2</u> Roadway Plans – The scope of the construction plans work will include:

- Updating the following plan sheets based on the drainage analysis, required outfall and additional turn lane:
 - o Key Sheet
 - o General Notes sheets
 - o Roadway Plan sheets
 - o Roadway Profile sheets
 - o Roadway Cross Section sheets
 - o Signing and Pavement Marking Plan sheets

<u>TASK 3</u> Drainage Analysis – The scope of the drainage analysis work for both Segment A and B consists of the following:

- Provide preliminary drainage calculation estimates to County to allow them to coordinate with property owner.
- Analyzing the pipe network, hydraulic analysis, and modeling the linear ponds, contributing area from the existing Hilltop Development property and outfall conditions.
- Analysis of stormwater is dependent upon pre/post calculations for Segment B as was discussed with SFWMD staff. Segment A will be required to meet water quality and quantity standards for the basin.
- Design new outfall into the C-17 Canal at the south end of the Hilltop Development. A relocatable outfall ditch is anticipated to be extend to the C-17 Canal to connect to an outfall structure.
- Redesign stormwater pond, drainage structures' locations, sizes, and inverts for Segment B to discharge into a reduced dry detention pond in Hi Acres.
- Design relocatable detention areas for Segments A for water quality, quantity and conveyance to outfall.
- Design control structure / outfall for Segment A and upgrade for Segment B permit.
- Drainage Reports
 - Provide new drainage calculations for Segment A and revise calculations for Segment B.
 - o Revise the drainage report to account for the changes in the drainage design.
 - o The narrative, hydraulic analysis, storm tabulations and summaries will be updated in the report for submittal to the County and SFWMD.
- SFWMD Permit Modifications
 - Modify both SFWMD permits for Segments A and B. Coordinate with SFWMD regarding updated drainage reports and construction plans for the two permit modification requests. Respond to one round of reasonable comments.
- This task will be dependent upon the County coordinating with the Hilltop Development regarding location of relocatable drainage easements.

• This task also includes providing drainage connections under Congress Avenue for the development on the east side of Congress Avenue by including manholes for connection and a stub out pipe.
