I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: **A) Receive and File Modification #3 to the FY21 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Miami and the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office, which extends the grant period from October 31, 2023 through December 31, 2023.**

Summary: On September 13, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) accepted a Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO) grant award in the amount of \$1,909,519 for the FY21 Urban Area Security Initiative Grant Program, for the period August 2, 2022 through June 30, 2023 (R-2022-1008). On April 18, the BCC accepted \$30,000 in supplemental funds (R-2023-0526). On July 11, 2023, the BCC approved an extension through October 31, 2023. This agenda item will extend the period of performance through December 31, 2023. **There is no match requirement associated with this award.** The Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) number is 97.067 and the contract number is R0521. Countywide (RS).

Background and Justification: The Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) is intended to create a sustainable national model program to enhance security and overall preparedness to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism. In general, the UASI provides financial assistance to States to address the unique equipment, training, planning, and exercise needs of large urban areas, and to assist them in building an enhanced and sustainable capacity to prevent, respond to, and recover from threats or acts of terrorism.

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: **A) Accept** on behalf of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the City of Miami for a FY21 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant in the amount of \$1,909,519 for the period of August 2, 2022 through June 30, 2023, and **B) Approve** a budget amendment of \$1,909,519 in the Sheriff's Grant Fund.

Summary: On July 8, 2022, the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO) received notification of a grant award in the amount of \$1,909,519 for the FY21 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program. The UASI is a federally-funded homeland security grant program, pass-through the State of Florida to the City of Miami, as the UASI's fiscal agent. The funds will be used for various domestic security initiatives within the County and the Southeast Florida Region 7, including intelligence operations, cyber security training, and equipment for our specialty teams and coastal RADAR System expansion project. **There is no match requirement associated with this award.** The Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) number is 97.067 and the contract number is R0521. Countywide (RS).
