Summary: On August 17, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved the annual low voltage contract (R2021-1063 through R2021-1069). The work consists of low voltage services to County-owned properties on an as needed basis. The Contractor now joins the list of twelve (12) prequalified contractors for a total of thirteen (13) prequalified contractors with a contract expiration date of August 16, 2026. The specific requirements of the work will be determined by individual work orders issued against this annual low voltage contract. These contracts are five (5) year indefinite-quantity contracts with a maximum cumulative value of \$4,000,000 across all prequalified contractors. Work will be awarded as work orders on a lump-sum, competitively bid basis across all prequalified contractors. Contractors may qualify at any time and be added to this annual low voltage contract before the term ends. Projects \$100,000 or greater are advertised on the vendor self-service (VSS) website and are bid among the pool of certified Small Business Enterprise (SBE) contractors, when three (3) or more small businesses are qualified under the contract. Projects \$200,000 or greater are advertised on the VSS website and additionally advertised in the newspaper, further expanding the bidding pool to include additional bidders responding to the specific project advertisement that submit a qualification application at least ten (10) calendar days before the bid due date. The annual low voltage contract was presented to the Goal Setting Committee on March 17, 2021 and the Committee established Affirmative Procurement Initiatives (APIs) of sheltered market for projects less than \$100,000 (when three (3) or more small businesses are qualified under the annual contract) or an SBE contractor will be given a price preference for projects \$100,000 or greater if its bid is within 10% of the lowest non-small business bid.
