Summary: On April 9), 2024, FDOT notified Palm T	ran that the final award amo	ount for three (3) pending applications		
Summary: On April 9, 2024, FDOT notified Palm Tran that the final award amount for three (3) pending applications had been finalized, and that amended Resolutions are needed to match the actual grant award. The applications, when submitted, included the price of vehicles established at the time of the applications. The State Contract to acquire these vehicles was modified in 2023, and there is price increase for which FDOT is providing additional funding contingent on the receipt of amended Resolutions by May 15, 2024. The resulting grant agreement requires a 10% match, the amended Resolutions reflect the increased amount of this match, which is included in Palm Tran's adopted FY2024 budget. Resolution R-2023-0615 does not have a change in the amount, only in the funding source, as requested by FDOT. Upon receipt of the amended Resolutions, FDOT will issue Public Transportation Grant Agreements (PTGAs) that will fund 90% of the purchase of 45 Replacement Paratransit vehicles, and will provide \$800,000 toward the operating costs for the Go Glades Service. Background and Justification (continued from page 1): FDOT has put on hold the award of Section 5310 Grants funding vehicles purchases. The grants require that purchase orders be made only from the FDOT Transit Research Inspection Procurement Services (TRIPS) Contract. Due to the COVID-19 aftermath, a shortage of vehicle chassis and other vehicle components, the vendors on TRIPS could no longer honor the price of the vehicles for orders issued in 2021 and 2022. FDOT started negotiations with the vendors in 2022 and final resolution and subsequent issuance of a new TRIPS contract was not completed until May 2023. FDOT has delayed the issuance of grant agreements for 5310 grants allocated in 2021, 2022 and 2023.

FDOT is working to release the backlog of awards pending from Fiscal Years 2021 to 2023. On April 9, 2024, FDOT requested Palm Tran submit amended Resolutions for the pending awards. Section 5310 provides funds for the purpose of assisting with transportation needs of the elderly and persons with disabilities.

On April 4, 2024, FDOT requested the amendment of the Resolution for Section 5311 operating funds, submitted by Palm Tran in 2023. The application applied for funds under the Off-cycle FY2021-2022, FDOT requested the FFY2023-SFY2024 to be used in the Resolution. FDOT requested this amendment to be submitted by May 15, 2024.

- The required ten (10%) percent match is included in Palm Tran's 2022 adopted budget.
