# I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:** Supplement #1 to Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 9 to the continuing consulting services/design professional services contract (R2019-1898) with Architecture Green LLC (Consultant) in the amount of \$318,435.89 for the North County Aquatic Complex-Restrooms and Locker Rooms Renovations project.

Summary: On December 17, 2019, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved the continuing consulting services/design professional services contract (R2019-1898) with the Consultant to provide architectural/engineering services for various projects. On February 6, 2024 the Board approved CSA No. 9 (R2024-0153) which authorized professional services necessary to renovate the existing 50 meter pool/dive well and construct a splash pad for the North County Aquatic Complex-Pool Renovation and New Splash Pad project. The Parks and Recreation Department desires additional services to renovate the existing men's and women's restrooms and locker rooms to better serve the users of the North County Aquatic Complex Facility. Under Supplement #1 to CSA No. 9 (Supplement #1), the Consultant will provide the professional services (i.e. design, construction document preparation, permitting and construction administration services) necessary for the North County Aquatic Complex-Restrooms and Locker Rooms Renovations project. The continuing consulting services/design professional services contract was presented to the Goal Setting Committee on August 7, 2019 and the Committee established Affirmative Procurement Initiatives (APIs) of a minimum mandatory 20% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation and an SBE evaluation preference for the selection. The Consultant committed to achieving an SBE goal of 100%. The SBE participation on this Supplement is 92.30%. To date, the cumulative SBE participation on the contract is 87.72%. The Consultant is a local and SBE certified firm. Funding for this project is from the Infrastructure Sales Tax Fund. (Capital Improvements Division) District 1 (MWJ)

**Background & Justification**: The design professional was selected on November 8, 2019, pursuant to the Consultants Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA), Florida Statute 287.055. Supplement #1 will provide the professional services necessary for the North County Aquatic Complex-Restrooms and Locker Rooms Renovations project which will benefit the residents of the community.

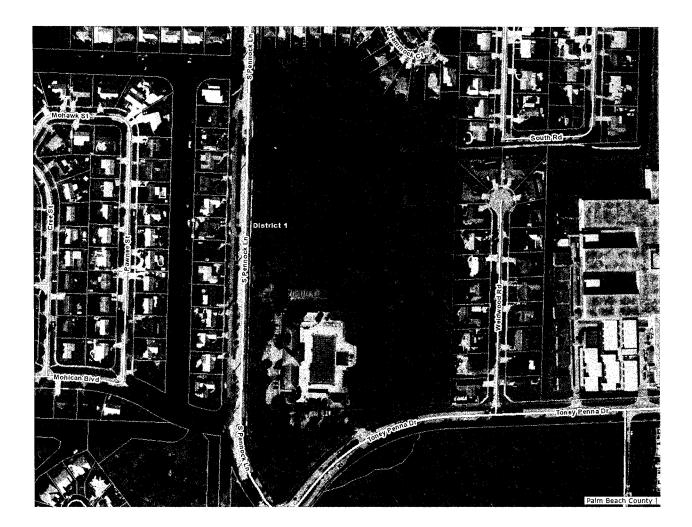

**4. Description of Services to be provided by Consultant:** Professional services shall include the design, document preparation, pennitting and construction administration services necessary for the renovations of the existing men's and women's restrooms / locker rooms, as detailed on the attached proposal dated 12/18/2023. In the event of a conflict between the terms and conditions of the Contract and the terms and conditions of Consultant's proposal, the terms and conditions of the Contract shall control.

5. Compensation: The compensation to be paid to the Consultant for the requested services shall be: Lump Sum charge of \$ 318,435.89.

6. This SUPPLEMENT may be terminated, in whole or in part, by the County with or without cause in accordance with the Contract terms. In the event of termination not the fault of the Consultant, the Consultant shall be compensated for all services performed to termination date, together with reimbursable expenses (if applicable) then due in accordance with the Contract terms.

Consultant agrees to waive any and all claims for lost profits or anticipated future profits in the event of a termination with or without cause under this Contract.

7. If not previously provided or for a new project, the Consultant shall provide County with an executed Conflict of Interest Disclosure Form, attached hereto and incorporated herein.

8. All terms, conditions, and obligations of the original Contract, as amended, shall remain in full

#### E-VERIFY - EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY

If COUNTY has a good faith belief that CONSULTANT's subconsultant has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes, as may be amended, COUNTY shall notify CONSULTANT to terminate its contract with the subconsultant and CONSULTANT shall immediately terminate its contract with the subconsultant.

If COUNTY terminates this Contract pursuant to the above, CONSULTANT shall be barred from being awarded a future contract by COUNTY for a period of one (1) year from the date on which this Contract was terminated. In the event of such contract termination, CONSULTANT shall also be liable for any additional costs incurred by COUNTY as a result of the termination.

9. Time of Commencement: Consultant shall begin work immediately on the requested services upon receipt of this executed document which shall constitute official "Notice to Proceed".

#### 10, EBO Program:

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The API established for this contract is a mandatory minimum of 20% SBE participation. The Consultant committed to an SBE participation of 100%. The SBE participation for this CSA is 92.30%. When added to the Consultant's participation to date, the resulting SBE participation is 87.72%.

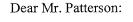

## MEN & WOMEN RESTROOM / LOCKER ROOM RENOVATION SCOPE OF WORK:

- Field measure Men and Women restroom / locker rooms and prepare CAD base of as-built.
- Demolition plans will be prepared in order to direct the Contractor to demolish the entire men and women existing interiors as required including Plumbing chase walls, plumbing, toilets, urinals, partition, lavatories, epoxy flooring, wall and tile, showers and associated plumbing. The Demolition plan will include a diagram indicating the areas to remove the existing slab in order to run underground plumbing to new locations.

In an effort to enhance services at the above referenced facility, the existing mechanical, plumbing, and electrical systems shall be reconfigured. JLRD shall review the MEP&FP system infrastructure to accommodate the proposed construction.

### Phase 2: General -

- o Provide construction package for complete renovation of existing restrooms.
- Mechanical
  - Renovated Areas:

- Replace existing exhaust fans and associated ductwork serving the men's and women's restrooms. Existing AHUs serving other areas such as offices, storage, etc. are to remain as is.
- It is assumed the existing air handling units provide sufficient outside air to accommodate the proposed finishes revisions without having to be replaced.
- Electrical It is anticipated the existing service entrance equipment, feeders, and panelboards are existing to remain and will not require replacement or upgrade as the building square footage remains the same.
