I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Work Order No. 24-001 to the annual electrical contract (2022-0694) with Zabatt Engine Services, Inc. dba Zabatt Power Systems, Inc. (Contractor) in the amount of \$2,198,176 for the Eagle Academy-Generator (Re-bid) project for a period of 450 calendar days from notice to proceed.

Summary: The project consists of the replacement of the existing generator with two (2) new generators. The existing generator has outlived its useful life and needs to be replaced. Additionally, the existing generator is unable to accommodate the future needs of the Eagle Academy Facility located at 38673 James Wheeler Way, Belle Glade, which currently support a secondary communications center for the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO). Work Order No. 24-001 authorizes the construction services necessary to furnish all labor, equipment, devices, tools, materials, transportation, professional services, supervision, drawings, permitting and all miscellaneous requirements necessary to remove the existing 1250 Kilowatt (KW) generator and replace it with two (2) new 800 KW generators and associated above ground fuel tank for the Eagle Academy Facility. The new generators will better serve the users of the facility and will also facilitate the future expanding needs of the facility. This project was competitively advertised and new contractors were invited to bid on the project by submitting prequalification documents prior to the submission of the bid response. The Contractor will have 450 calendar days from notice to proceed to substantially complete the project. Liquidated damages for failure to achieve certification of substantial completion within the contract time or approved time extension thereof are \$235 per day. This Work Order was solicited pursuant to the annual electrical contract and the requirements of the Equal Business Opportunity (EBO) Ordinance. The electrical annual contract was presented to the Goal Setting Committee on June 5, 2019 and the Committee established Affirmative Procurement Initiatives (APIs) of sheltered market for projects less than \$100,000 (when three (3) or more small businesses are qualified under the annual contract) or an SBE contractor will be given a price preference if its bid is within 10% of the lowest non-small business bid for projects \$100,000 or greater. Since this project is greater than \$100,000, the SBE price preference API was applied. The SBE participation on this Work Order is 0.46%. Cumulative SBE participation on the annual electrical contract is 52.79%. Funding for this project is from the Public Building Improvement Fund and 47.315M NAV Pub Imp Rev Bonds, 23C, CP, Var Fac Proj Fund. (Capital Improvements Division) <u>District 6</u> (MWJ)

Background & Justification: This project was openly, competitively advertised and procured. Bids for this project were opened on January 4, 2024 and the Contractor submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the three (3) bids received. The new generators will better serve the users of the Eagle Academy Facility and will also facilitate the future expanding needs of the facility.



WORK ORDER 24-001 TO ANNUAL CONTRACT R2022-0694 FOR ELECTRICAL

PROJECT NAME: EAGLE ACADEMY – GENERATOR (RE-BID) PROJECT NO. 2022-031302-R1

THIS WORK ORDER is made as of _______ by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as "Owner", and Zabatt Engine Services, Inc. dba Zabatt Power Systems, Inc., a Florida corporation, authorized to do business in the State of Florida, whose Federal ID# is 59-1889271 hereinafter referred to as "Contractor".

WHEREAS, the Owner and Contractor acknowledge and agree that the Contract between Owner and Contractor dated 7/12/22 (R2022-0694) ("Contract") is in full force and effect and that this Work Order incorporates all the terms and conditions of the Contract and the IFB/Q for this project, as may be supplemented and amended by this Work Order;

NOW THEREFORE, in exchange for the mutual covenants and promises set forth herein and the sums of money agreed to be paid by the Owner to the Contractor, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.
- **2. Total Bid Amount.** Pursuant to Section 6.3 of the Instructions to Bidders of the Annual Contract for Electrical between Owner and Contractor, the Contractor was the lowest, responsive, responsible Bidder in the amount of \$2,198,176.00 for the construction costs of removing existing 1250 KW generator and replacing with two (2) new 800 KW generators and above ground fuel tank as set forth on the **Bid Form** attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- **3. Schedule of Time for Completion.** The time of completion for this Work Order will be as follows: The Contractor shall substantially complete the project within **450** calendar days from notice to proceed. Liquidated Damages are \$235/day for failure to achieve certification of substantial completion within the contract time or approved extension thereof.
- **4. APIs.** The APIs applicable to this Contract are attached hereto.
- **5. EBO Participation to Date.** To date Contractor has achieved 3.76% SBE subcontracting participation on this Contract. Contractor will provide 0.46% on this Work Order.

7. <u>Annual Contract Modifications and Additions</u>. The following provisions of the Annual Contract are modified as follows:

Section 5.2 of the "Instructions to Bidders" of the Contract is modified to include the following new section:

5.2.5 Failure to Provide the Required Documents after Notification of Award. If after Notification of award from the County, the successful Bidder does not provide within 14 Days of Notification the signed Work Order, the Public Construction Bond and Guarantee (when required), and the required certificates of insurance, the County may: 1. Call in the bid security when provided; 2. Cancel the notification of recommended award and award the project to the next responsive, responsible low bidder; 3. Terminate this Annual Contract for cause; 4. Suspend or debar the Bidder from bidding on future projects for a period of two (2) years, in accordance with the Palm Beach County Purchasing Ordinance; and/or 5. Pursue any and all remedies available against the Bidder for damages resulting from its failure to enter into a Work Order and provide all required documents within 14 Days after notification.

The Insurance Coverage & Limit Table of General Condition 31.15 to the Contract is amended and modified as follows:

The following General Condition is added to the General Conditions:

GC 83 E-VERIFY - EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY

- 83.1 Contractor warrants and represents that it is in compliance with section 448.095, Florida Statutes, as may be amended, and that it: (1) is registered with the E-Verify System (E-Verify.gov) and uses the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers; and (2) has verified that all of the Contractor's subcontractors performing any duties and obligations under this Contract are registered with the E-Verify System and use the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers.
- 83.2 Contractor shall obtain from each of its subcontractors an affidavit stating that the subcontractor does not employ, contract with, or subcontract with an Unauthorized Alien, as that term is defined in section 448.095(1)(k), Florida Statutes, as may be amended. Contractor shall maintain a copy of any such affidavit from a subcontractor for, at a

minimum, the duration of the subcontract and any extension thereof. This provision shall not supersede any provision of this Contract which requires a longer retention period.

- 83.3 Owner shall terminate this Contract if it has a good faith belief that Contractor has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes as may be amended.
 - **83.3.1** If Owner has a good faith belief that Contractor's subcontractor has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes, as may be amended, Owner shall notify Contractor to terminate its contract with the subcontractor and Contractor shall immediately terminate its contract with the subcontractor.
- 83.4 If Owner terminates this Contract pursuant to the above, Contractor shall be barred from being awarded a future contract by Owner for a period of one (1) year from the date on which this Contract was terminated. In the event of such contract termination, Contractor shall also be liable for any additional costs incurred by Owner as a result of the termination.

The following General Conditions are added to the General Conditions:

GC 84 INTERACTIONS WITH COUNTY STAFF

In all interactions with County staff, Contractor and its employees will conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times and treat County staff with respect and dignity. Use of offensive and demeaning language will not be tolerated. Failure to comply with this requirement will be considered a default under this Contract and may result in termination of this Contract.

GC 85 <u>DISCLOSURE OF FOREIGN GIFTS AND CONTRACTS WITH FOREIGN</u> <u>COUNTRIES OF CONCERN</u>

Pursuant to F.S. 286.101, as may be amended, by entering into a contract or performing any work in furtherance thereof, the Contractor certifies that it has disclosed any current or prior interest of, any contract with, or any grant or gift received from a foreign country of concern where such interest, contract, or grant or gift has a value of \$50,000 or more and such interest existed at any time or such contract or grant or gift was received or in force at any time during the previous five (5) years.

8. Except as modified herein, the Contract remains in full force and effect. All capitalized terms herein shall have the same meaning as set forth in the Contract.




