I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF



Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: the Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium (RDCS) Renovation Project (Project) development period report no. 5 (Development Report No.5), for the period from January 23, 2024 through April 22, 2024, to the Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO).

Summary: On August 22, 2023, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) authorized the Mayor (R2023-1105) to execute future Development Reports and annual reports as required under the Spring Training Facility Funding Agreement (R2023-0367) (State Funding Agreement). On March 14, 2023, the Board approved the State Funding Agreement with the DEO for the RDCS Renovation Project. The State Funding Agreement provides \$50,000,000 of State Funding under F.S. 288.11631 over a 25 year period for the RDCS Renovation Project. Under the terms of the State Funding Agreement, the County must furnish annual reports and, during the development period, must submit periodic Development Reports every 90 days to the DEO. The Development Reports detail the status of the RDCS Renovation Project and the funds expended to date on the same. For the annual reports and the Development Reports, the Mayor must certify that all information and documentation contained in the reports are true and correct. In accordance with R2023-1105, the Mayor executed the attached Development Report No. 5 on behalf of the Board, which was submitted to the DEO. This executed document is now being submitted to the Board to receive and file. **(FDO ADMIN) District 1/Countywide (MWJ)**

Background and Justification: The State Funding Agreement provides for a total funding amount of \$50,000,000 to be equally disbursed to the County over a 25-year period for the RDCS Renovation Project. The State Funding Agreement requires that the County submit periodic Development Reports and annual reports, which must be certified by the Mayor.



Project Status Update with Summary of Activities Undertaken

Project Team

Owner: Palm Beach County (PBC)
Developer: Jupiter Stadium, Ltd. (JSL)
Project Manager: Marc Taylor Inc. (MTI)
Design Firm: Fawley Bryant Architects, Inc. (FBA)
Construction Manager at Risk: To be Determined – Contract negotiations underway

Status

The project remains in the pre-construction design and permitting phase. The Project Team continues to work on design documentation with the main goal of minimizing schedule impacts to the facility. The plan is to maintain Major League Baseball (MLB) and Minor League Baseball (MiLB) teams in Jupiter during the Spring Training, Extended Spring, Florida State League and Florida Complex League, with no missed seasons or need for relocation. As of this report, it is envisioned that minor/early work will be required during the 4th quarter of 2024 in order to facilitate the majority of construction improvements to occur in 2025.

The following list details the key activities undertaken during the reporting period.

- On February 11, 2024, the request for proposals (RFP) for construction manager at risk (CMR) services was advertised. Four companies submitted proposals by the due date of April 5, 2024 and the selection committee met to evaluate the same on April 19, 2024. The selection committee recommended one of the four proposers for award and contract negotiations are underway.
- 100% design development documents (including the review process) were completed as of March 6, 2024.
- 50% Construction Drawings were issued for review on April 5, 2024.
- As of this report, it is expected that construction activities will commence after the 2025 Spring Training season.

Permitting activities for the project during the current reporting period are summarized as follows.

- On March 5, 2024, the Project Team obtained approval for the site plan amendment from the Town of Jupiter.
- The Project Team plans to submit Building Permits in June 2024, with projected approval by end of July 2024.
