I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: **A) Receive and File** Modification #1 to the FY22 Urban Security Area Initiative (UASI) Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Miami and the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office, which extends the grant period from June 30, 2024 through October 1, 2024.

Summary: On August 22, 2023, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) accepted a grant award on behalf of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office, in the amount of \$1,518,726 for the FY22 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program for the period July 18, 2023 through June 30, 2024 (R-2023-1151). This agenda item will extend the period of performance through October 1, 2024. The UASI is a federally-funded homeland security grant program, pass-through the State of Florida to the City of Miami, as the UASI's fiscal agent. The grant supports various domestic security initiatives within the County and the Southeast Florida Region 7, including intelligence operations, cyber security training, and equipment for our specialty teams. **There is no match requirement associated with this award.** The Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) number is 97.067 and the contract number is R0588. Countywide (RS).

Background and Justification: The Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) is intended to create a sustainable national model program to enhance security and overall preparedness to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism. In general, the UASI provides financial assistance to States to address the unique equipment, training, planning, and exercise needs of large urban areas, and to assist them in building an enhanced and sustainable capacity to prevent, respond to, and recover from threats or acts of terrorism.
