I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Amendment No. 4 to the Contract with AVCON, Inc. (AVCON) for Consulting/Professional Services (Consulting Agreement) in the amount of \$174,678.26 for the performance of general airport consulting services related to the Palm Beach County Department of Airports Capital Improvement Program.

Summary: The Consulting Agreement with AVCON was approved by the Board of County Commissioners (Board) on September 13, 2022 (R-2022-1029) in the amount of \$796,697.19. Amendment No. 1 (R-2023-1441) through Amendment No. 3 (R-2024-0044) totaled \$931,984.65 and provided for various services, including, but not limited to, design services for the replacement of air handler units at Palm Beach International airport (PBI) and annual stormwater pollution prevention plan updates for the County's airports. Approval of this Amendment No. 4 will increase the contract amount by \$174,678.26 for a total contract amount of \$1,903,360.10. A detailed Contract History is included in Attachment 1. This Amendment No. 4 provides the following Consultant Services Authorization (CSA): Terminal and Concourses Fire Alarm Strobe Synchronization. AVCON is an Orlando, Florida based firm; however, the majority of the work will be completed through its Boca Raton, Florida office. On September 1, 2021, the Goal Setting Committee established a mandatory 20% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) subcontracting goal and a Minority/Women Business Enterprise Evaluation Preference up to 15% as the Affirmative Procurement Initiatives for the Consulting Agreement. The SBE participation for this Amendment No. 4 is 65.27%. The cumulative SBE participation for the Consulting Agreement, including this Amendment No. 4, is 51.02% Countywide (AH)

Background and Justification: In order to carry out the Capital Improvement Program for the County's Airport System, the Department of Airports requires professional consulting services. The Terminal and Fire Alarm Strobe Synchronization Project will update and synchronize fire alarm systems located at the Palm Beach International Airport.

AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO CONTRACT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF AIRPORTS AND AVCON, INC. FOR CONSULTING/PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AT PALM BEACH COUNTY AIRPORTS

This Amendment No. 4 to the Contract is made as of the 2nd day of 3ult, 2024, by and between **Palm Beach County**, Florida (COUNTY) and **AVCON**, **INC.**, a corporation authorized to do business in the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the CONSULTANT, whose Federal Tax I.D. number is <u>59-2890463</u>.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2022, the County entered into Agreement (R2022-1029) with the CONSULTANT for the CONSULTANT to provide Airport General Consulting Services for the Palm Beach County Department of Airports, for a period of two (2) years, with two (2) one (1) year renewal options, the exercise of which are within COUNTY'S sole control and discretion; and

WHEREAS, on October 3, 2023, the County entered into an Amendment No. 1 (R2023-1441) with the CONSULTANT for the CONSULTANT to provide additional professional services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 26 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on December 19, 2023, the County entered into an Amendment No. 2 (R2023-1858) with the CONSULTANT for the CONSULTANT to provide additional professional services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 26 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2024, the County entered into an Amendment No. 3 (R2024-0044) with the CONSULTANT for the CONSULTANT to provide additional professional services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 26 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS Article 26 of the Contract requires an amendment when the parties are able to define additional services,

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, and such other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which the parties hereby acknowledge, the parties agree to the following terms and conditions:

 The parties hereby agree to amend the Contract to include the Scope of Services and Fees as outlined in Exhibit A. The total amount to be paid by the COUNTY to the CONSULTANT for professional services, including any out-of-pocket expenses, shall not exceed <u>One Hundred</u> <u>Seventy-Four Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Eight Dollars and Twenty-Six Cents</u> (\$174,678.26) for the services described in this AMENDMENT NO. 4 to the original Contract.

Task I-24-PBI-AV-012 PBI Terminal and Concourses A & C Fire Alarm Strobe Synchronization Project

Palm Beach International Airport (PBI)

OVERVIEW

The Palm Beach County Department of Airports (DOA) has requested that AVCON, Inc. (AVCON) provide services related to the Task I-24-PBI-AV-012 for the Palm Beach International (PBI) Terminal and Concourse Fire Alarm Strobe Synchronization Project (Project). The DOA recently renovated and updated the PBI Concourse B building facility (including the fire alarm system and notification devices) and desires to update/synchronize the remaining old fire alarm system located throughout the PBI Terminal and the Concourse A & C buildings. The completion of the project will result in all fire alarm strobe lights flashing simultaneously, providing a clear and uniform visual signal to the passengers and building tenants, thereby enhancing the effectiveness of the fire alarm system.

PROJECT UNDERSTANDING

The Project work limits within the PBI Terminal and the Concourses A & C building areas are shown in the attached Exhibit A Project Work Limits Sketch, and Project generally consists of the following items:

- a. Modifications to the existing fire alarm system to replace approximately twenty-seven (27) outdated fire alarm digital amplifiers that are used for the fire alarm speakers.
- b. Modifications to the existing fire alarm system to replace the (2) outdated Onyxworks Workstations in the Coms Center and add one (1) new Onyxworks Workstation in the old Comm Center.
- c. Modifications to the existing fire alarm system to replace all outdated notification devices (strobes and/or speaker/strobes) to obtain strobe synchronization per the PBC Fire Marshal in the following PBI terminal/concourse facility locations:
 - Concourse A
 - Concourse C 2nd Level
 - FIS Area
 - Terminal Enplanement and Deplanement Roadway areas
 - Terminal 1st Level Electrical rooms, chiller plant and loading dock
 - Terminal 2nd Level offices between existing column lines 25 and 48
 - Terminal 3rd level offices behind the ticket counters
- d. The design effort includes and assumes up to (10) new notification power supplies will be required to accommodate the new strobes and/or speaker/strobes and assumes that the existing fire alarm panels will remain in place and not be upgraded.
- e. Design shall be per DOA's requirements, County Codes, Florida Building Code, National Fire Alarm and Signaling Code and National Electrical Code (NEC).
- f. It is assumed that the work will be completed by the DOA's Construction Manager and Includes responses to CMAR Constructability Review and associated plan revisions.

SECTION I - SCOPE OF SERVICES

AVCON's scope of services will be accomplished in two distinct phases: Phases 1 and 2. Phase 1 consists of three (3) subphases: sixty percent (60%) design completion of the Contract Documents (Phase 1A); ninety percent (90%) design completion (Phase 1B); and final design completion (100%) of Bid Documents (Phase 1C). Phase 2 consists of bidding and awarding of contract requirements.

Task 1 - Project Scoping, Management and Administration

The AVCON project manager will act as the primary point of contact for the DOA. AVCON's role will be to manage the AVCON Team and coordinate the design effort. Responsibilities include coordinating with subconsultants and preparing project scoping and contract documents, organizing a project Kickoff Meeting, requesting as-built documentation from the DOA for preliminary design and project setup, coordinating site visits with the DOA, arranging and attending project meetings, preparing meeting agendas and meeting minutes. The project task manager will ensure the project receives the level of attention and resources necessary for successful completion, confirm that the DOA comments are addressed and incorporated into the design documents, and compile an Engineer's Cost Estimate at each Design Submittal. AVCON will prepare project invoicing for the design team.

Task 2 - Project Design

2.1 - Project Kick-off Meeting

AVCON will organize a Kick-off Meeting to review the Scope of Work and present key project issues, review any concerns that the DOA may have, submit the proposed project schedule with intermediate milestones, review procedure for surveying/investigating the designated Terminal and the Concourse A and C spaces especially active tenant areas. Review current project budget and preliminary concept of establishing phased Construction Documents. Formally request archived as-built documents and setup initial site visits.

<u>2.2 – Documenting Existing Conditions</u>

The initial design work will include reviewing as-built documents and archived data for the Terminal, Concourse A & C areas for Architectural and Electrical/Fire Alarm design disciplines.

2.3 - Site Visits

Field inspections will be performed by the design team to confirm existing conditions for all areas within the project extents which are accessible. AutoCAD/Revit electronic files will be generated based on the available as-built plans and site observations.

2.4 – AVCON Project Design Tasks

A brief overview of the pertinent Project design tasks to be completed by AVCON includes the following:

- a. Prepare PowerPoint Presentations, sketches, and agenda for meetings (as applicable),
- b. Validate Program Cost Estimate.
- c. Facilitate Design Coordination meetings via conference calls and webinars.
- d. Develop Construction Phasing Plans (CSPPs) and MOT plans.
- e. Prepare and assemble 60%, 90% and 100% Contract Documents, Technical Specifications, Drawings, Project Schedule, Cost Estimates.
- f. Conduct Three (3) DOA Submittal Virtual Review Meetings. Prepare meeting agenda and meeting minutes (60%, 90%, and 100% Contract Documents).
- g. Task Management/Task Administration Coordination with DOA, DOA Operations, Permitting Agencies (if applicable), sub-consultants, and other stakeholders.
- h. Provide Quality Assurance for all deliverables.
- i. Prepare and Assemble Final Bid Documents for CMAR: Project Manual, Technical Specifications, and Drawings.
- j. Attend one (1) CMAR Pre-bid Meeting.

2.5 - QEE Electrical Design Tasks

QEE will perform the electrical engineering design services for the fire alarm notification synchronization upgrades in the PBI Terminal and Concourse A and C areas as specifically set forth in their Proposal dated January 24, 2024. The fire alarm design shall be per the DOA's

requirements, County Codes, the Florida Building Code, the National Fire Alarm and Signaling Code and the National Electric Code (NEC).

2.6 - Colome & Associates Architectural Design Tasks

Colome & Associates will perform the architectural design providing architectural drawings and specifications described in detail sufficient for construction of architectural repairs based upon the fire alarm synchronization conceptual design developed by QEE, and interior finish selections within the completed set of construction documents. Interior furnishing shall be selected and purchased by Palm Beach County Department of Airports. Colome shall also prepare and submit Project design documents for permitting to the Palm Beach County Building Department.

2.7 – Bidding and Award

The AVCON Team will assist the DOA and the DOA's CMAR firm with preparation of a presentation for use during a Pre-Bid Meeting. AVCON will attend and participate in the pre-bid meeting at the Airport, which will include a site visit. AVCON will respond to questions from the CMAR via the DOA, related to the Bid Documents. AVCON will assist the DOA with preparation of all required technical addenda to revise plans and/or specifications to respond to the CMAR's questions and provide clarification to the Bid Documents. AVCON will finalize the project cost estimate for bidding purposes.

After the DOA receives a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) proposal from the CMAR, AVCON will review one (1) GMP proposal and conduct an evaluation checking the accuracy of the GMP schedule of prices, including trade costs, schedule and the CMAR's assumptions. Upon completion of the GMP evaluation, AVCON will provide a written recommendation of award to DOA.

Conformed documents will be prepared incorporating all addendum information into the plans and technical specifications. PDF and hard copies of the Conformed Documents set plan drawings and the project manual will be provided to the DOA.



It is anticipated that the DOA staff review of the 60% and 90% plans, technical specifications and OPC estimates will be conducted concurrently with the CMAR constructability review during the 60% and 90% design phases.

PROJECT ASSUMPTIONS

- 1. In the event that the DOA and AVCON believe it to be in the best interests of the Project that additional services beyond what is provided in this scope of work be provided by AVCON, a separate Task Authorization, which specifies the proposed scope of services to be performed, will be prepared.
- 2. DOA shall pay additional compensation associated with efforts not specified in this proposal, if required. AVCON will notify the DOA in advance if this situation arises.
- 3. The design effort is based upon the requirements associated with a Level 1 Alteration under the Florida Building Code Existing Building.
- 4. The design effort is based upon the requirements associated with the current Palm Beach County P&Z Electrical & National Electrical Code and County Fire & NFPA Codes.
- 5. The proposal, scope of work, schedule and cost estimate has been prepared according to the information provided by the DOA. These may be adjusted according to the requirements and progress of the Project and any additional effort that may be required.
- 6. This proposal does not include construction administration or construction inspection services.
- 7. All permitting fees will be paid by the DOA.
- 8. This proposal does not include any fees or services to conduct asbestos surveys, obtain asbestos permitting or to perform asbestos abatement in the PBI terminal and concourses.

9. This proposal is established on the assumption that the project will be bid one (1) time and that the work will be awarded to a construction management firm, determined and selected by the DOA.




