# PALM BEACH COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS WORKSHOP SUMMARY

#### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Title: Public Housing Authorities Voucher Update

**Summary:** At the June 4, 2024 Board of County Commissioner's meeting, the Board discussed its desire to receive additional information regarding programs administered by the PHAs including various types of vouchers, and directed staff to set up a joint meeting with the various PHAs. Currently in Palm Beach County, there are seven (7) housing authorities. This includes the Palm Beach County Housing Authority and six (6) city housing authorities: Belle Glade, Boca Raton, Delray Beach, Riviera Beach, Pahokee, and West Palm Beach.

Housing Authorities in Florida are governed under Florida Statutes Chapter 421 and are created by a county or city's governing body. The governing body may adopt a resolution declaring a need for a housing authority if it is found that there is a shortage of safe or sanitary dwellings available to persons of low incomes; that those conditions cause a menace to the health safety and welfare of the residents, or there are blighted areas that cannot be revitalized. Appointments to city housing authorities are made by the city mayor with approval of the governing body. Appointments to county housing authorities are made by the Governor. The area of operation for a city with a population of less than 25,000, such as Belle Glade and Pahokee, includes the city and extends five miles outside the territorial boundaries. A city with a population of 25,000 or more, such as Boca Raton, Delray Beach, Riviera Beach and West Palm Beach, the area of operation extends ten (10) miles outside the territorial boundaries provided the boundaries do not lie within the area of operation of another city housing authority or outside the county as demonstrated in Attachment 1 to the Agenda Item. The area of operation for a county housing authority shall include all of the county except the portion of the county which lies within the territorial boundaries of any city. Countywide (HJF)

Background and Policy Issues: Providing affordable housing to very-low, low and moderate households in Palm Beach County is a critical issue. The County and the Housing Authorities partnership, along with other stakeholders, is essential to addressing the need for safe, decent and affordable housing. Housing authorities exercise public and essential governing functions which include, but are not limited to: the operation of housing projects providing for construction and reconstruction; distribution of vouchers; leasing or renting of houses, lands, buildings or facilities in any eligible housing project and within its area of operation; and investigate housing conditions to determine where slum areas exist or where there is a shortage of decent, safe, and sanitary dwelling accommodations for persons of low income and make recommendations relating to problems identified. Funding for programs managed by the housing authorities is primarily provided from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) including the HUD-Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing (VASH) Vouchers; however, housing authorities in rural areas may also receive funding from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA).


