#### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: A) Accept on behalf of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the City of Miami for a FY22 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant in the amount of \$1,518,726 for the period of July 18, 2023 through June 30, 2024, and B) Approve a budget amendment of \$1,518,726 in the Sheriff's Grant Fund.

Summary: On July 18, 2023, the Palm Beach County Sheriffs Office (PBSO) received notification of a grant award in the amount of \$1,518,726 for the FY22 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program. The UASI is a federally-funded homeland security grant program, pass-through the State of Florida to the City of Miami, as the UASI's fiscal agent. The funds will be used for various domestic security initiatives within the County and the Southeast Florida Region 7, including intelligence operations, cyber security training, and equipment for our specialty teams. There is no match requirement associated with this award. The Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) number is 97.067 and the contract number is R0588. Countywide (RS).
