I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Consultant Service Authorization (CSA) No. 5 to the Annual Structural Engineering Services Contract (R2023-0261) dated March 14, 2023 (Contract) with R.J. Behar & Company, Inc. (RJB) in the amount of \$144,557.74 for the Woolbright Road Bridge over Lake Worth Drainage District’s E-4 Canal (Emergency Repairs).

SUMMARY: Approval of this CSA is for the professional design services that were necessary for emergency repairs to the bridge approach slab that was undermined by a geotechnical boring that damaged a raw water main pipe located 40 feet beneath the bridge approach slab. The CSA also includes preparing a report to document the timeline and cause of the damage, and repairs to the adjacent road and bridge. The Engineering and Public Works Department (EPW) was notified by the City of Boynton Beach (City) of a potential sinkhole in the eastbound outside lane on Woolbright Road on March 13, 2024. EPW staff filled the depression and monitored this fix until April 2, 2024, when it was determined that the patch did not stop further sinkhole formation. At that point, EPW authorized a contractor to perform emergency exploration and provided CSAs to two consultants, including this CSA to RJB, to document the damage, determine the cause, and design the repair. The preliminary findings from these consultants determined that an unpermitted roadway core bored through a 42 inch raw water main and caused the bridge approach slab to become compromised. The City was able to install a liner within their damaged pipe and EPW’s contractor was able to finalize repairs in June 2024. It has been determined that the unpermitted bore work was performed in November 2021 by a Florida Department of Transportation consultant in advance of potential improvements at the Woolbright Road and I-95 interchange. Palm Beach County (County) intends to seek reimbursement for all professional design services costs, as well as the ultimate repair costs that the County was forced to make to ensure the integrity of Woolbright Road.

The Contract covering this CSA was presented to the Goal Setting Committee on January 5, 2022 and the Committee established Affirmative Procurement Initiatives (API) of a 20% minimum mandatory Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation of which 5% must be Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) participation for African American (AA) owned firms, and an SBE evaluation preference. RJB committed to 23% SBE and 18% MBE participation and received 6 Evaluation Preference Points. The proposed SBE participation for this CSA is 0%. To date, the overall participation achieved on this Contract is 15.81% SBE and 15.57% MBE. RJB has an office located in Palm Beach County (County). District 4. (YBH)

Background and Justification: On March 14, 2023, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the Contract with RJB to provide professional structural services throughout the County. The fee, as detailed in **Exhibit B** of the attached CSA, has been negotiated as just and reasonable compensation as follows:

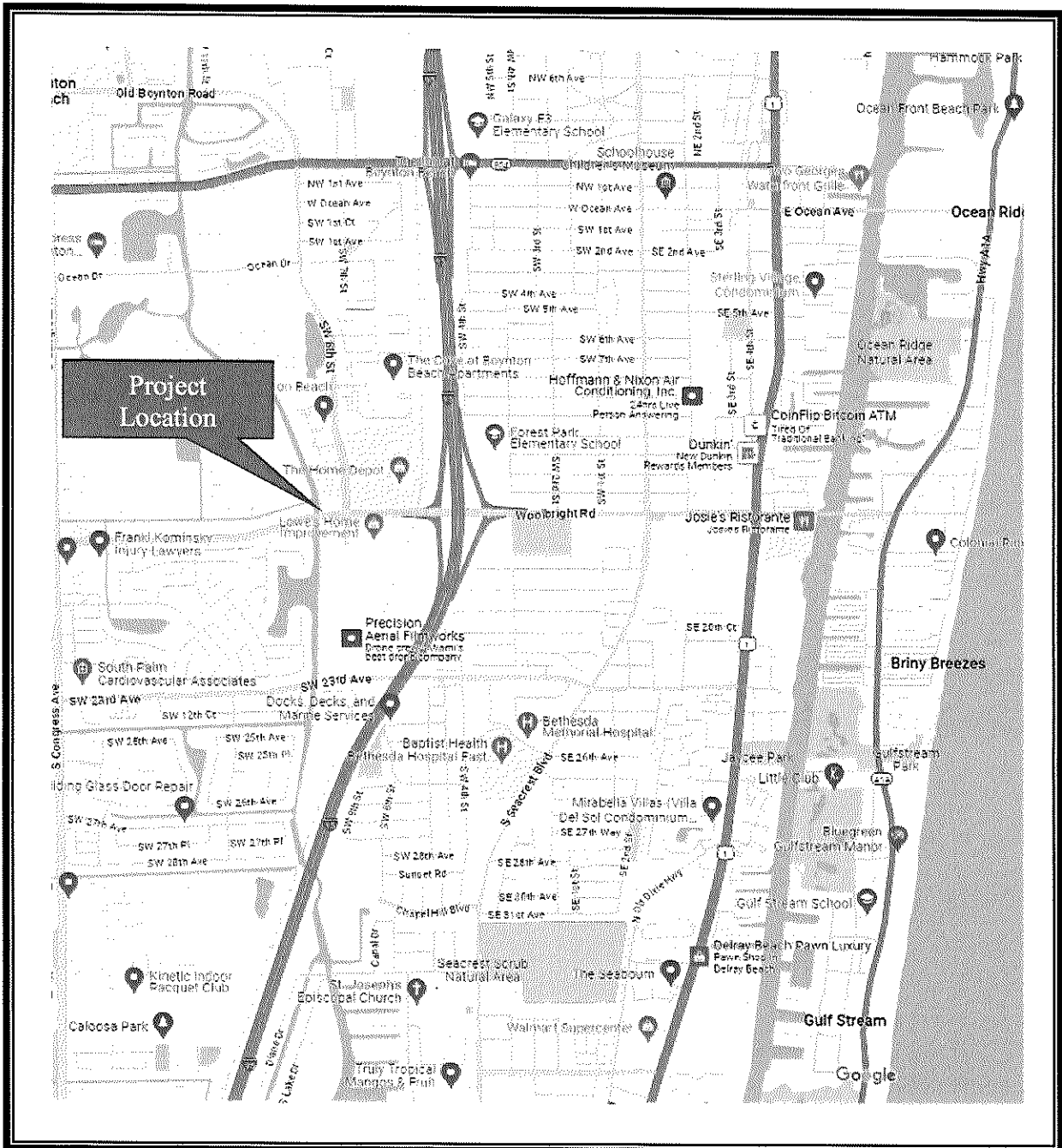

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

In 2022 a geotechnical boring was drilled through the eastbound approach slab at the east end of the Woolbright Road Bridge over the E-4 Canal. This boring damaged the raw water main approximately 40' below the approach slab. From 2022 to 2023 the raw water main was in service and gradually sucked soil from beneath the bridge approach slab into the pipe, thereby undermining the bridge approach slab. In March 2024 the approach slab dipped about 18". The Palm Beach County, Road and Bridge Division had the dip paved with asphalt. But several days later the approach slab failed, and the dip re-appeared. Road and Bridge immediately closed the outer 2 lanes, which remain closed today. On April 3, Palm Beach County contacted R. J. Behar to provide emergency engineering services for this bridge.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

R. J. Behar will provide highway and bridge engineering services to repair the approach slab and provide Palm Beach County with the necessary documentation to seek compensation for the expenses incurred to repair the undermined approach slab. Geotechnical engineering and construction testing services are being concurrently provided by RADISE International, Inc. under a separate contract. The following phases of engineering services will be provided by R. J. Behar and Company, Inc.;

1. **Design and Supervise Repairs:** R. J. Behar and Company, Inc. (RJB) will meet on-site with RADISE, Palm Beach County, Road & Bridge Division, the Contractor (Hinterland Group) and Specialty Subcontractors before each step of the repairs to determine the scope of the upcoming construction task, the engineering requirements and the material testing. RJB will take field measurements and request PBC to perform surveys as necessary. RJB will prepare complete construction plans for each task. These plans will be compiled in a single set of plans as the repairs progress. Throughout construction, RJB will be designing 1 or 2 tasks ahead of the current construction, to allow the Contractor to setup Specialty Subcontractors, order materials and mobilize equipment on site. A list of the major tasks is included in the price proposal. RJB will inspect critical items of the construction to supplement the inspections to be performed by the Palm Beach County, Road and Bridge Division.
2. **Report of Damage & Repairs:** RADISE international will take the lead role in preparing this document. RJB will review the preliminary report by RADISE and make proposed changes. We will also add text and illustrations to describe important observations,

measurements and photos we have taken. This joint RADISE/RJB report will be reviewed by Palm Beach County, Road and Bridge Division, administration and legal personnel. Additional issues and changes will be addressed as they are identified. Several revisions may be required. The scope of the report will be to document the timeline for the damage and repairs, cause of the undermining, the extent of the undermining and the repairs that were performed.

3. Assist County Legal Staff: The undermining of this approach slab is a very complex situation and the repairs are also complex. RJB will provide whatever information is necessary so that the County legal staff will have a complete understanding of this project. We have and will maintain very thorough records and photos of the project. If requested we will participate in the discussions between the County and opposing attorneys.

NOTES:

1. Due to the emergency nature of this project, some of the work included in this price proposal has been pre-approved by Mr. Steve Carrier PE (Assistant County Engineer) and performed by RJB prior to issuance of the Notice to Proceed.
2. This price proposal is setup as an hourly contract because of the unknown extent of the undermining of the approach slab and because of the undefined nature of the underground repairs which will be performed on a time and materials basis. If additional hours are needed, Palm Beach County will create a Supplemental Agreement to add the needed hours. RJB will make every effort to work efficiently on this project.


