I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Supplement No. 6 (Supplement) in the amount of \$124,725 to the contract (R2022-0335) dated April 12, 2022 (Contract) with HSQ Group, LLC (HSQ) for the Australian Avenue Drainage Improvements from Banyan Boulevard to 45th Street (Project).

SUMMARY: Approval of this Supplement will provide the professional services necessary for street lighting analysis and design of additional driveway improvements for the Project. This Project was presented to the Goal Setting Committee on October 7, 2020 and the Committee established Affirmative Procurement Initiatives (API) of a 20% minimum mandatory Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation and an SBE evaluation preference. HSQ committed to 88% SBE participation and received 13 Evaluation Preference Points. The proposed SBE participation for this Supplement is 0%. To date, the overall SBE participation achieved on this Project is 81.23%. HSQ has an office located in Palm Beach County. This Project is included in the Five-Year Road Program and has infrastructure sales tax funding. District 7 (YBH)

Background and Justification: On April 12, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the Contract with HSQ to provide the professional services required for the Project. The fee, as detailed in Exhibit B of the attached Supplement, has been negotiated as just and reasonable compensation as follows:

Basic Services (Lump Sum) \$116,625.00 (Lighting Plans, Roadway Plans and Survey)
Optional Services (Not to Exceed) \$8,100.00 (Post Design Services)

Total: \$124,725.00

After reviewing the attached Supplement and finding it in proper order, the Engineering and Public Works Department recommends BCC approval.



SCOPE OF SERVICES Australian Avenue Drainage Improvements from Banyan Boulevard to 45th Street Palm Beach County Project No. 2021827

Project Description:

The purpose of this SA 6 is to include lighting improvements along Australian Avenue from Banyan Blvd to 45th Street and to address the additional services related to the supplemental survey for 41 driveways and the design of the driveways.

Stanley Consultants, Inc. (Stanley) will provide lighting analysis and plans as show in the scope and hourly breakdown attached. HSQ Group, LLC (HSQ) will be responsible for the coordination between Stanley, FPL, Palm Beach County, and the City of West Palm Beach.

This request to address the survey and driveway design came from the county as a result of the public meetings. The proposed design is to provide turnaround driveways within the individual properties as identify previously and coordinated with the county. The limit of the original survey did not cover the full extent of the footprint of these driveways. Therefore, supplemental design survey will be conducted to aid in the design to obtain additional information and topo for 41 driveways.

Design and grading of the driveways will be added to the plan sheets and 41 driveway profiles will be revised to reflect the design.

Optional services will consist of post design services to include RFI responses, shop drawing reviews and to attend necessary construction meetings for lighting items.

Project Schedule:

The additional driveway survey and design will be done within 30 days of the Notice to Proceed and the lighting design services will be done within 8 months from the Notice to Proceed.

Lighting Design Scope

Date: May 6, 2024

Project Description and Basic Services:

As part of the Australian Avenue Drainage Improvements from Banyan Boulevard to 45th Street project roadway lighting improvements are proposed. Australian Avenue is being reconstructed to provide a four-lane divided facility with 11 ft travel lanes, outside 4 ft paved shoulders, curb and gutter (inside and outside), and 6-8 ft sidewalks. The proposed lighting improvements include 3-mile-long corridor lighting along Australian Avenue throughout the project limits. Supplemental lighting will be provided at the two signalized intersections (Banyan Blvd and Palm Beach Lakes Blvd) to complement the signal mast arm luminaire lighting to meet pedestrian crosswalk lighting at these two intersections. Per the County's direction no additional lighting will be needed at the mid-block crossing south of 25th Street.

The proposed roadway lighting will be on FPL poles. FPL is relocating their existing facilities to the back of the proposed sidewalk. Coordination with FPL will be necessary to confirm the new FPL pole locations that can be utilized for the proposed lighting as well as the appropriate FPL luminaires and mounting height for use in the lighting analysis. Additional FPL poles may be necessary to meet the corridor lighting criteria and the pedestrian crosswalk lighting criteria. The existing median lighting (not on FPL poles) are owned by the City of West Palm Beach and are proposed to be removed. Coordination with the City is anticipated for the removal of these poles.

A Lighting Design Analysis Report (LDAR) including the photometric analysis will be prepared. Associated lighting plans reflecting the proposed FPL light pole locations, mounting height, and luminaire to be used for each pole will also be prepared for use in coordinating with FPL so they can finalize the design for installation of the proposed lighting improvements. FPL will determine service point locations including load centers. FPL construction personnel will install the proposed lighting improvements. The lighting plans showing the proposed FPL light pole locations are for information purposes only and not intended to be constructed by the roadway contractor.

A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) will be prepared noting the approximate number of new FPL streetlights for use in generating an agreement with the appropriate governmental agency with regard to the associated monthly maintenance and energy costs associated with the new FPL lighting. The MOU will be routed to the governmental agency for signature and sent to FPL with the proposed lighting plans so they can prepare the FPL construction plans for the lighting.

Design Submittals:

The LDAR, 96% lighting plans and the MOU will be submitted to the County for review prior to submitting the Final Plans and Final LDAR to Palm Beach County and FPL.
