Background and Justification: PBCWUD's Uniform Policies and Procedures require Standard Development Agreements to obtain concurrency for water and/or wastewater service. The terms and conditions for Standard Development Agreements are outlined in the PBCWUD Uniform Policies and Procedures Manual. The BCC delegated the authority to execute various types of Standard Development Agreements, and related documents including Standard Indemnity Agreements to the Department Director including potable water and wastewater agreements (R93-1619); reclaimed water agreements (R96-0228); and additional conditions for potable water, wastewater, and reclaimed water agreements (R2003-0539).

- A) Amendment to Standard (Potable Water, Wastewater, and/or Reclaimed Water) Development Agreement with Boynton Beach Marketplace, LLC, SDA #05-11133-000 (District 5), Recorded in OR BK 35109 PG 166. This Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located on the northwest corner of Boynton Beach Boulevard and Hagen Ranch Road, 4.10 Equivalent Residential Connections (ERC's) for both water and wastewater for five (5) years.
- B) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Agreement with BC Boynton Industrial LLC, SDA #05-11139-000 (District 5), Recorded in OR BK 35086 PG 460. This Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located on the northeast corner of Boynton Beach Boulevard and Acme Dairy Road, 74.90 ERC's for both water and wastewater for five (5) years.
- C) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Agreement with KLLB AIV LLC, SDA #05-11140-000 (District 6), Recorded in OR BK 35200 PG 116. This Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located on the west side of State Road 7 approximately 2,200 feet south of Hypoluxo Road, 167.70 ERC's for both water and wastewater for five (5) years.
- D) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Agreement with Oikos Development Corporation, SDA #15-01001-000 (District 6), Recorded in OR BK 35200 PG 126. This Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located on the east side of Barfield Highway at East 2nd Street, 43.60 ERC's for both water and wastewater for five (5) years.
- E) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Agreement with Pulte Home Company, LLC, SDA #02-01179-000 (District 6), Recorded in OR BK 35200 PG 106. This Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located along the south side of Lake Worth Road east of State Road 7 and west of Hunting Trail, 119.47 ERC's for both water and wastewater for five (5) years.
