Motion and Title: Staff recommends a motion to approve: Appointment of one (1) new member to the Construction Industry Licensing Board (Board), for the term January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2027



Summary: The Board establishes qualifications and competency of contractors that work within the County. The Board also provides for the testing and licensing of these contractors, and is empowered to discipline licensees, and hear citation appeals. The Board was established by Special Act, Laws of Florida, Chapter 67-1876, as amended. The Special Act and, subsequently, Section 489.131, Florida Statutes sets forth the membership of the Board, which consists of 15 members. This Board shall be comprised of 15 members as follows: two (2) general contractors, one (1) member from each of the following contractor categories: building, residential; electrical; plumbing; HARV (Heating, Air Conditioning, Refrigeration and Ventilation), roofing; swimming pool; one (1) architect; one (1) engineer and one (1) full-time building official employed by a local government within Palm Beach County, who meets the requirements of the Building Officials Association of Florida; and three (3) consumer representatives. A memorandum was sent to the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) on October 17, 2024 requesting support to appoint one (1) new CILB board member, no other nominations were received. The Board currently has ten (10) out of 15 seats filled and a diversity count of Caucasian: 9 (90%) and Hispanic-American: 1 (10%). The gender ratio (female: male) is 2:8. Staff is addressing the need to increase diversity within our boards and will continue to encourage this to expand this Board's diversity. Countywide (RM)

Background and Justification: The membership of the Board consists of two (2) general contractors, and one (1) member of the following categories: building, residential, electrical, plumbing, HARV roofing, swimming pool, architect, engineer, and building official. In addition, Section 489.131, Florida Statutes requires that we have three (3) Consumer Representatives. The Board establishes qualifications and competency of contractors that work within the County. The Board also provides for the testing and licensing of these contractors, and is empowered to discipline licensees.

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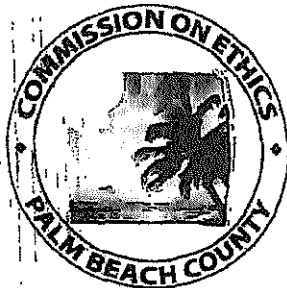

Re: New Appointment to the Construction Industry Licensing Board (CILB) of Palm Beach County

Purpose: This memo requests a nomination for the Construction Industry Licensing Board (CILB) Roofing Member. The appointment would be effective for a full three-year term commencing on January 1, 2025 and ending on December 31, 2027. The Palm Beach County Roofing & Sheet Metal Contractors Association (PBCRSMA) has nominated Mr. Peter Dzenutis for your consideration and approval.

BACKGROUND: The CILB's primary function is to approve certificate of competency construction trade licenses for Palm Beach County. The CILB consists of 15 members, including two general contractors, one building contractor, one residential contractor, one electrical contractor, one plumbing contractor, one HARV contractor, one architect, one engineer, one full-time building official within Palm Beach County, one roofing contractor, one swimming pool contractor, and three consumer members. The primary term of office is three years, and no member shall serve for more than two consecutive terms but may be re-appointed after a three-year hiatus. The qualifications to be appointed to this board include being actively engaged in the construction business in Palm Beach County, holding a certificate of competency in their name, being a resident of Palm Beach County, and having been engaged in the construction business for at least five consecutive years immediately before the date of their appointment. The roofing member must be licensed in the State of

Florida and reside in Palm Beach County. The Board currently has thirteen seats filled. This memorandum requests the approval of one new member, bringing the participation to fourteen members.

Special Act, Chapter 67-1876, Laws of Florida as amended

Board Member Qualifications

Section 3. Construction Industry Licensing Board of Palm Beach County, organization, meetings, powers, duties. —

- (A.) The Construction Industry Licensing Board of Palm Beach County is hereby created and composed of the following: two general contractors, one contractor who is primarily engaged in the business of furnishing those services to which a building contractor is limited, one contractor who is primarily engaged in the business of furnishing those services to which a residential contractor is limited, one electrical contractor, one plumbing contractor, one HARV contractor, one roofing contractor, one swimming pool contractor, one architect, one engineer, and one full-time building official, employed by a local government within Palm Beach County who meets the requirements of the Building Officials Association of Florida. All members of the Board shall be appointed by the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners.
- (B.) To be eligible for appointment each contractor member shall be:
- (1) Actively engaged in the construction business in Palm Beach County and have held a certificate of competency in his name and have been so engaged for a period of not less than 5 consecutive years immediately before the date of his appointment, and be a resident of Palm Beach County. The architect and engineer member shall be licensed in the State of Florida and be a resident of Palm Beach County.
 - (2) Each member of the Board except the Building Official shall hold a valid certificate issued by this Board or the state of Florida in addition to having the qualifications required in subsection (B) (1) above.
 - (3) In the event that any member of the Board no longer possesses the qualifications required in subsection (B) (1) and (B) (2) above, said member may be suspended or removed as a member of the Board upon a majority vote. If a member fails to attend three successive, regular scheduled meetings, he may be removed by a majority vote of the Board.
- (C.) All terms of office expire on September 30 of the last year of the term. As the terms of members expire, the Board of County Commissioners shall appoint a member to fill the vacancy for a term of 3 years, but no member shall serve for more than two consecutive terms but may be reappointed after a three (3) year hiatus. Vacancies in the membership of the board for any cause shall be filled by the Board of County Commissioners for the balance of the unexpired term.



Board Member Qualifications

Florida Statutes 489.131 Applicability:

(10) No municipal or county government may issue any certificate of competency or license for any contractor defined in s. 489.105(3)(a)-(o) after July 1, 1993, unless such local government exercises disciplinary control and oversight over such locally licensed contractors, including forwarding a recommended order in each action to the board as provided in subsection (7).

Each local board that licenses and disciplines contractors must have at least two consumer representatives on that board. If the board has seven or more members, at least three of those members must be consumer representatives. The consumer representative may be any resident of the local jurisdiction who is not and has never been, a member or practitioner of a profession regulated by the board or a member of any closely related profession.
