#### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:** Amendment No. 6 to the Contract for Consulting/Professional Services (Consulting Agreement) with HDR Engineering, Inc. (HDR), in the amount of \$457,560.56 to provide supplemental services for a previously approved task related to the North County General Aviation Airport (F45) Terminal Ramp Expansion (Ramp Expansion Project).

Summary: The Consulting Agreement with HDR for airport design and engineering services was approved by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) on August 20, 2019 (R2019-1157) in the amount of \$960,107. Amendment No. 1 through Amendment No. 5 increased the contract amount by \$1,125,926.42 and provided for various planning, design and construction phase services, including, but not limited to, services for the Palm Beach International Airport Cargo Access Improvements, F45 Runway 9R/27L Pavement Rehabilitation, and Palm Beach County Park Airport Runway 4/22 Pavement Rehabilitation projects. Approval of this Amendment No. 6 will increase the amount of the Consulting Agreement by \$457,560.56 for a total contract value of \$2,543,593.98. A detailed contract history is included in Attachment 1. While the term of the Consulting Agreement has expired, it authorizes amendments to be issued after its expiration for supplemental services needed to complete a task authorized prior to the expiration of the Consulting Agreement. Amendment No. 2 approved on June 7, 2022 (R2022-0574) authorized Task I-22-F45-H-005 for design the Ramp Expansion Project. Amendment No. 6 provides supplemental construction phase services required to complete the Ramp Expansion Project. HDR is an Omaha, Nebraska based firm; however, the majority of the work is managed from its West Palm Beach office. A Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation goal of 20% was established for the Consulting Agreement. HDR committed to 20% DBE participation. The DBE participation for Amendment No. 6 is 54%. The cumulative DBE participation to date, including Amendment No. 6, is 26%. Countywide (AH)

**Background and Justification:** HDR is the consultant responsible for the design of the Ramp Expansion Project. Supplemental construction phase services are required to complete the Ramp Expansion Project.

This Amendment No. 6 to the Contract is made as of the day of awary, 2025, by and between Palm Beach County, a Political Subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as the COUNTY, and HDR Engineering, Inc., [] an individual, [] partnership, [X] a corporation authorized to do business in the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the CONSULTANT, whose Federal Tax I.D. number is 470680568.

#### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on August 20, 2019, the COUNTY entered into an Agreement (R-2019-1157) with the CONSULTANT for the CONSULTANT to provide Consulting / Professional Services for the Palm Beach County Department of Airports at Palm Beach County Airports (PBI, F45, LNA, & PHK); and

WHEREAS, on August 17, 2021, the County entered into an Amendment No. 1 (R-2021-1024) with the CONSULTANT to exercise the first one (1) year renewal option for the continuation of services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 25 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2022, the County entered into an Amendment No. 2 (R-2022-0574) with the CONSULTANT to exercise the second one (1) year renewal option for the continuation of services and to provide additional professional services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 25 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on August 23, 2022, the County entered into an Amendment No. 3 (R-2022-0887) with the CONSULTANT to provide additional professional services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 25 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on March 5, 2024, the County entered into an Amendment No. 4 (R-2024-0233) with the CONSULTANT to provide additional professional services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 25 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2024, the County entered into an Amendment No. 5 (R-2024-1556) with the CONSULTANT to provide additional professional services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 25 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Article 25 of the Contract requires an amendment when the parties are able to define additional services and the parties have now defined those services;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, and such other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which the parties hereby acknowledge, the parties agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. The parties hereby agree to amend the Contract to include the Scope of Services and Fees as outlined in Exhibit A. The total amount to be paid by the COUNTY to the CONSULTANT for professional HDR ENGINEERING, INC.

services, including any out of pocket expenses, shall not exceed Four Hundred Fifty-Seven Thousand, Five Hundred Sixty Dollars and 56 Cents (\$457,560.56) for the services in Amendment No. 6 to the original contract.

2. The first paragraph of Article 2 of the Contract is hereby amended to delete the last sentence in its entirety and replace it with the following:

The parties acknowledge and agree that additional services may be required to complete services, tasks or work authorized prior to the expiration of the Contract ("Supplemental Services"). In the event the COUNTY requires Supplemental Services, the parties shall enter into an agreement for the provision of the Supplemental Services by the CONSULTANT, which shall be subject to the same terms and conditions as the Contract except as specifically provided for in the agreement for Supplemental Services. This parties agree the CONSULTANT's agreement to provide Supplemental Services in accordance with the provisions of this Article 2 shall survive the expiration or early termination of the Contract.

3. The Contract is hereby amended to add the following:

#### **ARTICLE 36 – HUMAN TRAFFICKING AFFIDAVIT**

The CONSULTANT warrants and represents that it does not use coercion for labor or services as defined in section 787.06, Florida Statutes. The CONSULTANT has executed Exhibit F, Nongovernmental Entity Human Trafficking Affidavit, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

4. Except as specifically amended herein, all other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.

#### **SCOPE OF SERVICES**

Description of the services outlined below in Section 0.0 - General is intended to be general in nature and should not be construed to be a complete description of the services or a limitation on the Scope of Services to be provided. Refer to Sections 1 through 8 for the definition of specific scope items to be performed by HDR.

#### 0. GENERAL

#### 0.1 THE PROJECT




Figure 1 Terminal Ramp Expansion Overall Project

The Palm Beach County (COUNTY) Department of Airports' (PBCDOA) North Palm Beach County General Aviation Airport (F45) is a general aviation airport. It is served by a terminal ramp on the east central airfield. HDR Engineering, Inc. (CONSULTANT) designed the 9,100 square yard expansion of the terminal ramp as shown in Figure 1.

After completion of design and bid phase services for the project, known as the Terminal Ramp Expansion, the PBCDOA wishes for Consultant to provide construction phase services.

Construction activities will generally consist of construction of airfield pavements and supporting infrastructure.

#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND GENERAL SCOPE

Consultant will provide construction services as a task under its Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with the COUNTY.

The services consist of the following scope items:

- Construction administration
  - Generally described as information review and processing, such as submittal review, RFIs, pay app review, evaluation of substitutions, certification, etc. This work is typically performed under the supervision of the Engineer of Record (EOR).

- Quality assurance
  - Generally described as the procedures performed on behalf of the PBCDOA to fulfill the PBCDOA's responsibility to monitor that construction work completed complies with specifications for acceptance.
- Resident Project Representative (RPR)
  - Generally described as the firm(s) duly authorized by the PBCDOA to be responsible for inspections, observations, tests, and/or observations of tests of the contract work performed or being performed, or of the materials furnished by the Contractor, and acting directly or through an authorized representative.

CONSULTANT will provide the services of a senior RPR to monitor written communications, attend meetings, and issue records of decision. The CONSULTANT shall provide daily observation reports to the PBCDOA.
  - 1. The CONSULTANT shall provide an on-site RPR for the periods shown in Table 1.

  - 4. Asphalt Laydown/Lighting Plan
- 5. Inspections and Tests
  - 1. Schedule, perform, and review PBCDOA's quality assurance inspection and testing as described in the technical specifications. Performance of tests and inspections work to be performed by SUBCONSULTANT TSF.
  - 2. Through subconsultant TSF, perform geotechnical investigations for unforeseen field conditions during construction
    - o 2 asphalt pavement cores, including through the base course
    - 2 SPT borings to 10-ft depth
    - 1 soil sieve analyses

  - 3. Receive and review certificates of inspections, tests, and approvals required by the Construction Contract Documents. CONSULTANT's review of such certificates will be for the purpose of determining that the results certified indicate compliance with the Construction Contract Documents and will not constitute an independent evaluation that the content or procedures of such inspections, tests, or approvals comply with the requirements of the Construction Contract Documents. RPR shall be entitled to rely on the results of such inspections and tests.
- 6. The CONSULTANT will review up to 8 contractor pay applications and recommend either rejection, approval, or partial approval to the PBCDOA.
  - 1. CONSULTANT will track quantities of work performed on a daily basis and reconcile quantities with the contractor on a weekly basis.
- 7. After notice from Contractor that Contractor considers the entire work ready for its intended use, in company with PBCDOA, EOR, and Contractor, visit the site to review the work and determine the status of completion. The CONSULTANT shall perform a substantial completion site visit review and provide a punch list of open items for the contractor to address for each phase of work and at the end of the construction phases. CONSULTANT will incorporate the PBCDOA's and EOR's punch list items into the master punch list. CONSULTANT will recommend to the PBCDOA on what date the substantial completion notice should be recorded.
- 8. The CONSULTANT shall perform a final completion site visit to observe the contractor's work to address the punch list. CONSULTANT will recommend to the PBCDOA on what date the final completion notice should be recorded.
- 9. Subconsultants shall provide specific RPR duties in accordance with Table 1.
  - 1. QEE shall provide a part-time RPR for electrical work.
  - 2. CRJ shall provide a daily on site civil RPR.
  - 3. CMA shall provide RPR for work involving stormwater conveyances.
  - 4. HDR shall provide a part-time senior RPR for critical work periods, such as control strips, unforeseen field conditions, and phase completion punchlist development.

CONSULTANT shall maintain a tracking log of RFI status.

- 13. Substitution request evaluation. CONSULTANT shall evaluate contractor's request to substitute or make minor modifications to up to 4 components of the contract scope.
- 14. Phasing Coordination. Consultant shall perform the following activities for each phase transition, up to 4 phases.
  - 1. Solicit contractor's anticipated phase start date.
  - Develop a written phase commencement request to DOA Operations, detailing the work to be done, the work areas and times, anticipated closures of facilities required, and suggested MOT exhibit.
  - 3. Coordinate phase area, work dates/times, etc. minor adjustments between DOA Operations and the Contractor, with up to 1 in-person meeting per phase anticipated.
- 15. Review and document QA and acceptance tests. CONSULTANT shall review quality assurance and materials acceptance testing for compliance with the contract documents and notify the contractor of work that does not meet the contract requirements. CONSULTANT shall document testing results and submit to the DOA at the completion of construction.
- 16. Contractor Pay Applications. The CONSULTANT will review up to 8 contractor pay applications and recommend either rejection, approval, or partial approval to the COUNTY.
  - Financial reporting. Consultant shall provide monthly breakdowns of value of work completed for each project funding source and work component, based on the approved contractor invoice amount.
  - 2. The CONSULTANT will provide up to 8 monthly DBE status monitoring reports.
  - 3. The CONSULTANT will submit each contractor pay application as a package with associated review memo.
- 17. Substantial Completion. After notice from Contractor that Contractor considers the entire work ready for its intended use, in company with COUNTY and Contractor, visit the site to review the work and determine the status of completion. The CONSULTANT shall perform a substantial completion site visit review and provide a punch list of open items for the contractor to address for each phase of work and at the end of the construction phases. CONSULTANT will incorporate the COUNTY's and EOR's punch list items into the master punch list. CONSULTANT will recommend to the COUNTY on what date the substantial completion notice should be recorded. Substantial completion activities shall be performed for 4 phases of work.
- 18. Final Completion. The CONSULTANT shall perform a final completion site visit to observe the contractor's work to address the punch list. CONSULTANT will recommend to the COUNTY on what date the final completion notice should be recorded.
- 19. Maintenance Guidance. Upon issuance of the substantial completion notice, CONSULTANT shall provide maintenance checklists and schedules for materials and equipment installed under the project.
- 20. Contractor's Completion Documents. CONSULTANT will receive from Contractor, review, and transmit to Owner maintenance and operating instructions, schedules, guarantees, bonds, certificates or other evidence of insurance required by the Construction Contract Documents, certificates of inspection, tests and approvals. CONSULTANT will receive from Contractor, review, and transmit to Owner the annotated record documents which are to be assembled by Contractor in accordance with the Construction Contract Documents to obtain final payment. The extent of CONSULTANT's review of record documents shall be to check that Contractor has submitted the information required by the contract documents.
- The CONSULTANT shall provide engineer's certification to funding sources and permitting authorities.

Chen Moore and Associates, Inc. (CMA) is pleased to submit the following Scope of Services and associated fee estimate to assist your team with the drainage and permitting services for the referenced project.

#### PROJECT INTRODUCTION

The Palm Beach County (COUNTY) Department of Airports (DOA) North Palm Beach County General Aviation Airport (F45) is designated as a reliever for Palm Beach International (PBI) and serves helicopters, reciprocating engine aircraft, and jet aircraft. The existing apron is situated east of Runway 14-32, north of Runway 9R-27L and adjacent to the FBO terminal building and hangars. The apron currently provides approximately 82 tie-down spaces over an aircraft parking area of approximately 40,550 square yards. The existing apron has 34 tie-down spaces sized for small single engine aircraft and 48 tie-down spaces sized for multi-engine aircraft. In addition to the aircraft tie-down locations, the apron provides two parking positions for helicopters.

The 2006 Airport Master Plan Update (MPU) and the 2018 draft Activity Demand Projections report both forecast increased demand for parking on the terminal apron. Historically, airplane design group (ADG) I aircraft have comprised most of the parked fleet at F45. In the future, ADG II aircraft are projected to become a larger portion of the fleet with the anticipated extension of Runway 14-32. The COUNTY completed a study in 2020 to evaluate ramp expansion layout alternatives to meet the increase in parking demand and up-gauging of the fleet.

The alternatives evaluated 3 development scenarios:

- 1. Runway 14-32 existing alignment and existing Runway Design Code B-II
- 2. Runway 14-32 existing alignment and upgraded Runway Design Code C-II
- 3. Runway 14-32 shifted 60 feet further from the ramp and upgraded Runway Design Code C-II




FIGURE 1: Original Depiction of Cargo Access Road Improvements.

Alternative 3 was selected as the preferred alternative for its maximization of ramp space and because it was the mostly likely outcome of the Runway 14-32 Extension Environmental Assessment. Figure 1 shows the preferred alternative 3 ramp expansion recommended in the study.




FIGURE 2: Depiction of Revised Stormwater Management Area per Value Engineering Evaluation

After moving through design it was determined that the project cost needed to be reduced and a value engineering study was completed. CMA's understanding of the Stormwater scope as a result of the value engineering study has been reduced to the area depicted in Figure 2.

The COUNTY had it's consultant team, led by HDR proceed with design and production of construction documents for the ramp expansion in general compliance with recently value engineered alternative.

#### **SCOPE OF SERVICES**

#### TASK 1.1 - Engineering and Construction Support for Stormwater

CMA shall be responsible for the site inspection of the stormwater improvements included as part of the final design for the F45 Terminal Ramp Improvements project consisting of minor stormwater structure modifications, pipe culvert installation, and swale grading. It is anticipated that CMA's onsite work is assumed to be in total of 11 days of field observation and will consist of site visits for material delivery, dewatering inspections, stormwater infrastructure installation, substantial completion walk through, and final completion walk through. CMA anticipates the review and approval of ten (10) shop drawing submittals as part of this scope. CMA anticipates the review and response to four (4) RFIs as part of this scope. CMA assumes that these RFIs will not result in the need to issue a plan revision to the design plans and any approved modifications can be handled through the as-built documentation process.

#### **SCHEDULE AND FEES**

As requested, Tierra South Florida, Inc. (**TSFGeo**) is pleased to submit this proposal for providing Geotechnical and Construction Material Testing Services for the above-referenced project. Herein, we provide a general discussion of services that we understand will be required for this project, present our Schedule of Fees for such services.

#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Our proposal is based on preliminary information provided to this office. We understand that geotechnical investigation, soil, concrete, asphalt monitoring and laboratory services are required for the expansion of the terminal ramp on the east central airfield.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS**

TSFGeo is a recognized SBE consulting engineering and testing firm providing integrated services in several disciplines, including geotechnical engineering, construction services, materials engineering & testing, roof & pavement consulting, threshold services, and facilities consulting and engineering.

TSFGeo's Florida offices, located in West Palm Beach, Miami and Tampa, have over 40 engineers, inspectors, and support staff available to assist our clients. Our inspectors are ACI and AWS trained/certified in their respective disciplines, as required by building codes and industry standards. Our engineering staff includes registered professional engineers with significant construction experience in South Florida.

The Geotechnical Report will include exhibits and figures to illustrate the geotechnical investigation and findings.

Prior to drilling at the project site, TSF will notify the local utility companies and request that underground utilities be marked. Our experience, however, is that the utility companies will not mark privately owned or airside utilities. All utilities will need to be cleared via GPR by a specialty utility locating company, or by the airport. It is our understanding that the work will be conducted during the daytime. Our fieldwork will be performed by TSF personnel, escorted by HDR personnel.

Our estimate covers the work needed to present our findings in a formal report. Not included are reviews of foundation drawings, preparation of construction specifications, special conferences and any other work requested after submittal of our report.

Boring, sampling, and testing requirements are functions of the subsurface conditions encountered. Therefore, the estimated fee previously indicated is approximate, and compensation for the exploration will be based on the actual work and tests performed. We will endeavor to keep the exploration cost at a minimum consistent with good engineering practice. Based on our understanding of the project a breakdown is attached.
