#### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- A) A Budget Transfer in the amount of \$191,000 in the Housing and Economic Development Fund to increase the budget for the Belle Glade Intake and Assessment Center Renovations project;
- **B)** A Budget Amendment of \$191,000 in the Public Building Fund to recognize the transfer from the Housing and Economic Development Fund; and
- C) Amendment No. 1 to the continuing Construction Manager (CM) at Risk Services contract (R2023-0141) with Waypoint Contracting Inc. (Waypoint), establishing a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) in the amount of \$712,941.02 for the Belle Glade Intake and Assessment Center Renovations project, Phase 1, for a period of 150 calendar days from notice to proceed.

Summary: On February 7, 2023, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the continuing CM at Risk Services contract (R2023-0141) with Waypoint for construction management services for various federally funded projects. The Belle Glade Intake and Assessment Center is in need of renovations to better serve individuals and families experiencing homelessness in the western region. Project renovations include, but are not limited to, exterior enhancements, interior enhancements and the replacement of the existing building systems that have outlived their useful life. These renovations will improve public access to the facility, harden the facility to provide better weather protection and allow the facility to be in compliance with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and current Building Code requirements. Task Order No. 1 authorized the preconstruction services for the Belle Glade Intake and Assessment Center Renovations project. Amendment No. 1 establishes a GMP in the amount of \$712,941.02 for construction management services necessary for the Belle Glade Intake and Assessment Center Renovations project, Phase 1. The Belle Glade Intake and Assessment Center Renovations project, Phase 1 includes, but is not limited to, windows and doors replacement, reinforcement work, masonry infill, exterior painting, stucco, structural reinforcement of the building pilings and exterior slabs, asphalt paving, fencing, and parking lot lighting. The CM will have 150 calendar days from notice to proceed to substantially complete the construction phase of the project. Liquidated damages for failure to achieve certification of substantial completion within the contract time or approved time extension thereof are \$120 per day. The continuing CM at Risk Services contract was selected through a competitive solicitation in accordance with the federal requirements. This continuing CM at Risk Services contract is exempt from the County's Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance pursuant to section 2-80.22 thereof. The work was competitively solicited by Waypoint utilizing the federal requirements provided by the Department of Housing and Economic Development (DHED). (Continued on Page 3)



**Summary:** Under the federal requirements, this project has an established Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) goal of 22.4% minority participation and 6.9% is female participation. The CM anticipates an EEO utilization of 47.01% minority participation and 3.98% female participation for the Belle Glade Intake and Assessment Center Renovations project, Phase 1. Funding for this project is from the Public Building Improvement Fund and Housing and Economic Development Fund. (**Capital Improvements Division**) **District 6** (MWJ)

**Background and Justification:** CM at Risk is a project delivery method in which the CM provides design phase assistance, evaluation of cost, schedule and implications of alternate designs, systems and materials, and serves as the general contractor bidding the subcontracts for construction. Amendment No. 1 authorizes the construction management services necessary for the construction of the Belle Glade Intake and Assessment Center Renovations project, Phase 1.

#### AMENDMENT #1 Waypoint Contracting Inc TO CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AT RISK SERVICES ON A CONTINUING CONTRACT BASIS FOR FEDERALLY FUNDED PROJECTS PROJECT NAME: BELLE GLADE INTAKE AND ASSESSMENT PROJECT NO.: 2021-051653

This Amendment is made as of <u>January 14</u>, 2025 by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as Owner, and Waypoint Contracting Inc, authorized to do business in the State of Florida, whose federal tax ID# is 81-4602789, hereinafter referred to as "Construction Manager".

WHEREAS, the Owner and Construction Manager acknowledge and agree that the Continuing Contract between Owner and Construction Manager dated February 07, 2023 (R2023-0141) (hereinafter the Continuing Contract) is in full force and effect and that this Amendment incorporates all the terms and conditions of the Continuing Contract including the Federal Requirements attached to Task Order #1 as may be supplemented and amended by this Amendment.

WHEREAS, under Task Order #1, Owner assigned Project No. 2021-051653 (the Project) to Construction Manager under the Continuing Contract and set forth all of the Federal Requirements applicable to the Project;

WHEREAS, the parties have now established a Guaranteed Maximum Price for Phase 1 of the Project, including the Construction Manager's fees calculated in accordance with the Construction Manager's Price Proposal attached to the Continuing Contract, whereby the Construction Manager will render construction and warranty services and other services as set forth herein and in the Continuing Contract;

**NOW THEREFORE**, in exchange for the mutual covenants and promises set forth herein and the sums of money agreed to be paid by the Owner to the Construction Manager, the parties agree as follows:

1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.

2. Construction Manager's Representations. The Construction Manager represents that:

The Construction Manager, Trade Contractors, Sub-subcontractors, material and equipment suppliers have compared Phasing, Demolition, Architectural, Structural, Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing, Civil and Site Drawings and Specifications and have compared and reviewed all general and specific details on the Drawings and that all conflicts, discrepancies, errors and omissions, which are within the commonly accepted knowledge base of a licensed general contractor, subcontractor, trades persons, manufacturers or other parties required to carry out the Work involved in this Amendment,

have been corrected or clarified prior to execution of this GMP Amendment to the Continuing Contract, and therefore Construction Manager warrants that the GMP (exclusive of contingency) includes the cost of correcting all conflicts, discrepancies, errors, or omissions which Construction Manager identified, or should have identified through the exercise of reasonable skill and care, during the preconstruction phase of this Project.

The Construction Manager's review and comparison of all Drawings has taken into consideration the total and complete functioning of all systems and therefore the Construction Manager represents that the GMP represents the total cost for complete and functional systems.

**3. Federal Requirements.** Construction Manager reaffirms, certifies, represents and warrants that it will continue to comply with all Federal Requirements as set forth in Task Order #1.

**4. Guaranteed Maximum Price.** Pursuant to Section 2.2 and Article 6 of the Continuing Contract between Owner and Construction Manager, the parties have agreed to a Guaranteed Maximum Price of \$712,941.02 for the construction phase of Phase 1 of the Project. The GMP is based on the following: Exhibit A. In the event of a conflict between the terms and conditions of the Continuing Contract and the terms and conditions of Construction Manager's GMP proposal, the terms and conditions of the Continuing Contract shall control.

**5. Schedule of Time for Completion.** The time of completion for this Amendment will be as follows: The Construction Manager shall substantially complete the work within 150 calendar days from the Notice to Proceed from Owner. Liquidated Damages are \$120/day for failure to achieve certification of substantial completion within the contract time or approved extension thereof.

**6. EEO Goal.** An EEO goal of 22.4% minority participation and 6.9% female participation has been established for this Project. Construction Manager anticipates an EEO utilization of 47.01% minority participation and 3.98% female participation in this construction phase.

#### 7. Wage Rates.

- All work will be conducted during normal working hours, Monday to Friday between 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM
- The Phase 1 Works to include:
  - All exterior demolition and civil works.
  - All structural and reinforced works for all building pilings & building exterior slabs.
  - Earthwork and grading, including all geotechnical stabilization to support the new sidewalks per Geotech Report with a geogrid textile under the sidewalks. Note Geotech report calls for Mirafi textile fabrics plans calls for Piling.
  - All site lighting poles and Fixtures, and the misc. electrical panel works to support the new exterior lights. With added fixtures for parking lot lighting per permit review comments revision #2
  - Exterior site fencing and gates per revision # 2
