

- 1.Program Coordinator- Part-Time Position- Program Coordinator will oversee the program components to allow the cirriculum development so that all facets will come to their optium level for success. The Coordinator will also oversee various elements such as scheduling workshops, seminars, networking activities, and daily management of program elements.
- 2. Curriculum Developer- Part-Time Position- Curriculum Developer will be responsible for developing and coordinating the program.

We believe exposing youth to these experts will give them a broader knowledge base to make informed decisions.

Our program will be based at the Judge Edward Rodgers Center for Community Development which will allow the program to be exposed to underserved, at-risk youth in the community. Occupying a large conference style room for meetings and seminars, classroom space for mentoring sessions, workshops and other activities that will allow the program to serve the youth.

#### Organization Purpose:

Give under-served children and families equal opportunities to succeed in school, work, and in life, to grow into successful adults and be positive contributions to our community

#### Provide a brief summary of program's activities/services to be funded:

Out-of-School Time (OST) program for 350 school-age students year-round after school, non-school days, holidays & summer camp. Students are picked up from 12 area schools and stay until 5:30pm; 7:30a-5:30p on full days. They receive snacks, socialization, homework support, individualized/small group activities, tutoring and dinner; plus, use of Chromebooks and supplies needed to complete homework and projects. Free, therapeutic interventions are provided on campus by 50+ partner providers seemlessly integrated into our programming. After homework, we offer Space and technology-focused enrichment to ensure kids have access to high tech skills, and eventually, high paying jobs. The curriculum emphasizes social and emotional learning, life skills, daily fitness with indoor/outdoor sports, service-learning component, and the arts- music, dance, visual arts & drama.

#### What results are you committed to achieving?

Our program prevents crime, giving at-risk youth structured activities, addressing an urgent need. Last year, the Wayne Barton Study Center, across the street from Fuller East shut its doors after 20 years, leaving hundreds of youth from low-income at-risk homes nowhere to go once school is out. Studies show juvenile crime spikes 2 to 6pm- between school dismissal and parents' arrival from work. OST programs reduce unsupervised time, lower dropout rates, reduce addictive & criminal behavior, and reduce loW-income achievement gaps. Children involved in extracurriculars are 400% more likely to go to college than kids who aren't. But, youth from under-resourced homes are 3X less likely to attend OST programs. Students who dropout are 63X more likely to be incarcerated than college grads. Dropout rates are highest for Black (31 %) & Hispanic (33%) students.



These hands-on, experiential events introduces students to high-growth, high-wage career fields and helps them explore potential career paths in an engaging and interactive environment. Each fair will feature exhibits, including at least one from law enforcement, where representatives are able to provide educational materials and information for students. 

#### Organization Purpose:

The Palm Beach County Police Athletic League (PAL) builds partnerships between youth, law enforcement, and the community through recreational and educational programs designed to encourage, enhance, and develop good citizenship improving the quality of life in Palm Beach County.

Provide a brief summary of program's activities/services to be funded:

Monies will be used to find a tutoring program for the youth at our four PAL Sites: Cabana Colony, Westgate, Lake Worth, and San Castle. PAL recruits teachers from the Palm Beach County School District to tutor our youth that are academically behind in math, reading, and science. The tutors come in 4 days a week, Monday through Thursday, 3 hours each day for 32 weeks of the school year. Each site has at least two tutors working with the youth individually offering assistance. PAL pays them a stipend for their time, \$35/hr and issues a 10-99 at the end of each year. An increase in the hourly wage is due to the school district paying this amount and we need to pay the same wage in order to employ the teachers of the school district for tutoring.

What results are you committed to achieving?

The goal of our PAL tutoring program is to provide academic services to the under-served youth assisting them academically to become better students through the efforts of the tutors thus improving their grades.

If approved, this funding will serve disabled veterans (disability determined by the VA) and their families by providing urgent financial assistance in the areas of housing, transportation, and other essentials in the Palm Beach VAMC area. Although many veterans qualify for financial aid from the VA, federal financial disability aid can take a long time to process, compounding the financial and emotional stress experienced by veterans and their families. Veterans experiencing financial crisis, and who have received a VA disability rating, are referred to WVRF by case managers at the VA facility. Once a veteran referral is received and processed, WVRF intervenes and provides urgent financial relief within 48-72 hours by distributing payment directly to the creditor (e.g., paying the landlord directly).

#### What results are you committed to achieving?

Wounded Veterans Relief Fund (WVRF) exists to offer relief to qualified disabled veterans who are experiencing urgent situations that require immediate intervention, offering immediate solutions to avoid crises such as homelessness or job loss. The most pressing need among veterans and families is housing assistance. Organizational records show that 82% of the veterans assisted do not seek additional funding and are self-sufficient moving forward. Veterans often face unique challenges when transitioning back to civilian life. Physical and mental health, a stable living situation, as well as financial stability and employment are important concerns for many disabled veterans and their families. As a veteran-led organization, WVRF has created programs that focus on meeting critical needs that have an immediate impact on the stability of veterans and families.
